- Outdoors closes at 11pm
- Neighbors notified

- Music off by 11pm, 12am on weekend.

Presentation and review for the renewal of a current on-premises liquor license application submitted to the State Liquor Authority on behalf of Prime Six Inc. at 242 Flatbush Avenue (between Bergen Street/6th Avenue).
