Description: Gas-fired, infrared radiant patio heaters, designed for outdoor installation for industrial and commercial use only. Unit is comprised of infrared burner, reflector, a piezo-spark ignition system comprising electrode, flame sensor assembly, spark lead manual gas valve and combination gas pressure regulator. Units, with model numbers and input heating rating, are listed below:

Note: Minimum installed clearances from combustible construction shall be accordance with RS 14-15 of the New York City Building Code.

Terms and Conditions: The above-described units, constructed for commercialindustrial type and non-residential type heating operations, are accepted with the following conditions:

- 1. Units are for outdoor use only, with combustion air and required ventilation air provided, where clearances from adjacent combustible shall be accordance with RS 14-15 of the New York City Building Code.
- 2. Units shall use natural gas only.
- 3. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- 4. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to those tested and accepted for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
