Terms and Conditions: The above described air handling units are accepted under the following conditions:

- 1. Units shall be installed indoors only.
- 2. If utilized for residence heating, circulatory air system shall have (a) one register or grille without closeable shutters and the duct leading thereto shall be without a damper or, (b) dampers and shutters within the system shall be constructed or controlled so as to prevent closure beyond 80 percent of the gross duct area at all times.
- 3. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and acceptable for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code,
- 4. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 5. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
