Units consist of fin and tube evaporator, blower and controls. Units with model numbers, heating and cooling capacities are listed below:

Terms and Conditions: That the above described air heating circulatory units be accepted for indoor installation under the following conditions:

- 1. If utilized for residence heating, circulatory air system shall have (a) one register or grille without closable shutters and the duct leading thereto shall be without a damper or (b)) dampers and shutters within the system shall be constructed or controlled so as to prevent closure beyond 80 percent of the gross duct area at all times.
- 2. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
- **3.** Approval pf all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials, and devices shall be obtained from the Department before installation.
