Description: Condensing and compressor units, #14AJA- series, designed for outdoor installation. R-22 is the refrigerant used for the system. Unit is comprised of air-cooled condenser, hermetically-sealed compressor, and controls. Unit is provided with an internal relief assembly within the compressor. Units, with model numbers and cooling capacities, are listed below:

Terms and Conditions: The above-described air-cooled condensing units are accepted under the following conditions:

- 1. Units shall be installed outdoors only.
- Units shall use Refrigerant R-22 only.
- 3. A tag must be permanently affixed to the equipment stating that if installed in New York City within 100 feet of any dwelling window, there shall be compliance with all provisions of Section 27-770, as to maximum sound levels permitted for exterior mechanical equipment.
- 4. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 5. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- 6. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and acceptable for use, as provided in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
