<u>Electrical Ratings</u>: 120VAC, 60Hz, 1650 Watts 220VAC, 60Hz, 1650 Watts **Terms and Conditions:** The above-described electric holding cabinets are accepted under the following conditions:

- 1. Minimum installed clearances from combustible construction shall be in accordance with RS 14-15 of the New York City Building Code.
- 2. Units shall be installed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and New York City Building, Electrical and Fire Codes.
- 3. Adequate supply of fresh air for unit ventilation and combustion requirements shall be provided into room or space enclosing equipment.
- 4. The installment shall not obstruct access for operation and servicing.
- 5. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 6. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
