Description – Popcorn machines intended to be free standing units. They are for either in stationary, mobile or serving stations. Units comprise heating elements, light bulbs, on/off switches and thermal cut off.

PRODUCT COVERED:

Model CM25C and CM25E with or without suffix LH or RH caramel corn machine.

ELECTRICAL RATINGS:

The units are rated 120/208 volt or 120/240 volt, 6 Hz, 3000W.

Recommendation – That the above commercial electric popcorn machines be accepted, under the following conditions:

- 1. Units shall be installed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and New York City Electrical Code requirements.**
- 2. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and acceptable for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.**
- 3. Approval of electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Bureau of Electrical Control before installation.**
