Description: Gas-fired unit heaters designed for indoor or outdoor installation for horizontal, upflow and downflow discharge, to supply make-up air to non-residential spaces. Unit is comprised of a direct gas-fired burner, ignition system, flame safeguard and combination gas-pressure regulator, high temperature limit control, air-flow switch, centrifugal blower(s) and modulating dampers. Units, with model numbers, air-flow range and input heating ratings, are listed below:

Non re-circulating direct gas-fired Industrial Air Heaters.

Series R, model number followed by 318, 320, 327-427, 330-430, 336-436, 340-440, 344-444, 349-449, 354-454, 360-460, 366-466, 373-473, 380-480, 389-489, followed by U or H, followed by O (100% OA constant volume) or V (100% OA variable volume), followed by X (Maxon Burner), E (Eclipse Burner) or M (Midco Burner).

Terms and Conditions: The above-described direct-fired gas make-up air heaters are accepted for operation under the following conditions:

- 1. Minimum installed clearances from combustible construction shall be in accordance with RS 14-15 of the New York City Building Code.
- 2. Heaters shall not be operated until installation is approved for such operation by the Gas Company.
- 3. Approval of all electrical equipment, apparatus, materials and devices shall be obtained from the Department's Electrical Advisory Board before installation.
- 4. Units shall be used in compliance with the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State.
- 5. All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to that tested and accepted for use, as provided in Section 27-131 of the New York City Building Code.
