Description- Automatic washing machine, front loading, models (A, S, U) X 18, 25, 35, 55, 75, 100, 135 and 165, with dry load capacity 18 to 165 pounds, designed for commercial application. Unit consists of heavy-duty motor, stainless steel wash basket with shock absorbers, fabric selector, temperature control, and brake system.

Note: The units shall be provided with backflow preventers per Section of P104.12 Reference Standard RS 16 of the Building Code.

Recommendation- That the above washing machine be accepted for use when installed in conformance with Reference Standard RS 16.

All shipments and deliveries of such equipment shall be provided with a metal tag, suitably placed, certifying that the equipment shipped or delivered is equivalent to those tested and accepted for use, as provided for in Section 27-131 of the Building Code.
