SUBJECT: MEA boiler acceptances

As discussed at yesterday's Superintendents' meeting, several qualified field testing laboratories have registered with the MEA Division and are available for performance of statutory testing requirements at the job site.

This procedure would enable refiling with the MEA Division and recertification of individual boiler sizes within the model line on a job to job basis, in lieu of submittal for laboratory testing, and hopefully offer the boiler companies a feasible alternative.

The following is the current list of MEA boiler acceptances. This listing, which reflects the recently cancelled boiler acceptance numbers as well as recent acceptances, supersedes all previous boiler listings.

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
