Revision to C 26-35.0 of the Building Code - Crane on-site inspection and fees as described in Local Law 50/73.

On September 21, 1973 the Mayor signed Local Law 50/73 which became effective intediately. Copies of the new legislation are forwarded herewith. The following procedures shall be effective upon filing hereafter of building notice applications for crase on-site inspections ( Form 21 C ).

- I) Ordans with boom lengths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which are less than 250 fact:
  - 1.) Fee remains \$25.00
- II) Or was with boom lengths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which are 250 feet and longer and which are inspected during the no unl work week:
  - 1.) Fee increased to 350.00
  - 2.) Plan exhainer shall notify the applicant that approval of the above noted machines by Grane and Perrick Division is required. This shall be noted on an Objection sheet. Grane and Derrick Division will that he and note on the examiners objection sheet whether an appointment has been made for the inspection of the crane. If appointment is may the plan exhainer shall continue to examine the building notice application for on-site inspection.

The Grame and Derrick Division will notify the chief construction in patter of the borough involved of the scheduled crame inspection and the chief construction inspector shall schedule an on-site inspection in conjunction with the crame division.

- III) Chanes with boom lengths, including jibs and extensions thereof, which are 250 fest and longer and which are to be inspected by the Chane and Derrick Division on days other than the normal work week ( Inturbays, Sundays and holidays ):
  - 1. Per increased to 100.00
  - 2. Plan examiner shall notify the applicant that approval of the above noted machines by Grane and Derrick Division is required. This shall be noted on an Objection sheet. Grane and Derrick Division will check fee and note on the examiners objection sheet whether an appointment has been made for the inspection of the crane. If appointment is made the plan examiner shall continue to examine the building notice application for on-site inspection.

The Crans and Perrick Division will notify the chief construction inspector of the borough involved of the sheduled crane inspection and the chief construction inspector shall schedule an on-site inspection in conjunction with the crane division, except construction inspectors will not make Saturday, Sunday or holiday inspections.

IV) Fees shall be paid to Borough Cashier at time of filing of Building Notice Applications.
