SUBJECT: Demolition of Unsafe Structures -
Occupied Housing Accommodations Statement
Section C26-113.2 sub b

The occupied Housing Accommodations Statement shall not be required when demolition permit applications are filed for buildings to be demolished pursuant to contracts issued by the Department of Development or by (H.U.D.) Housing and Urban Development Department.

Since each of the buildings is reinspected, there is ample reassurance that the structures are vacant of all tenants before the permit is issued and it can therefore be assumed that there are no occupied housing accommodations subject to control and that the intent of the law is not violated.
