Certificates of Correction to Launch in DOB NOW: Safety

Beginning December 15, 2025, all Certificate of Correction (COC) requests are required to be submitted in DOB NOW: *Safety*. COC requests that were submitted in DOB NOW: *BIS Options* before this launch will continue in BIS Options. COC requests still in pre-filing status on the launch date will be cancelled and will have to be submitted in DOB NOW: *Safety*.

Submit a COC Review Request

- Login to DOB NOW at nyc.gov/dobnow,
- Select the DOB NOW: Safety module and then Violations & Notices of Deficiency.
- From the **Violations** dashboard, select **+Certificate of Correction Review Request** and enter the summons number.
- Complete all required sections, including the **Documents** and **Signatures & Statement** tabs.
- Save and submit the COC for review
