

SERVICE UPDATE

Elevator Permit Applications + Category 3&5 Inspections: Electronic Submission

Beginning September 7, 2015, the Elevator Unit will accept requests for copies of outstanding Elevator Permit Applications and requests for copies of outstanding penalties for Category 3 & 5 Inspections (Look-up sheets) <u>via email only</u>. Customer Service representatives will no longer accept these requests in person and will direct constituents to email these inquiries.

Email Submission Process

- 1. Email requests for copies of outstanding Elevator Applications and Category 3&5 Look-up Sheets to the following email addresses.
 - Copies of Elevator Applications: elepermitcopies@buildings.nyc.gov
 - Category 3&5 Look-up Sheets: <u>elelookup@buildings.nyc.gov</u>
- 2. For Copies of Outstanding Elevator Permit Applications
 - The Elevator Unit will conduct a search for outstanding permit application/s and send an email notification including the fees owed and instructions to resolve.

For Category 3&5 Outstanding Penalty Requests

- The Elevator Unit will calculate the fees owed and send an email notification of the amount due to the constituent.
- 3. Constituents should print the notice and present with payment to the cashier in person at 280 Broadway, 4th Floor, New York, NY 10007. Obtain payment receipt.
- 4. To obtain copies submit payment receipt by email or in person at 280 Broadway, 6th Floor, New York, NY 10007.
- 5. Once payment receipt is submitted, copies will be provided to the constituent and applicable violations will be dismissed.

Reminder: Building owners must have a Category 3&5 inspection and test within 3 & 5 years from the month of issuance of a final certificate for a new elevator or within 3 & 5 years from the month of the most recent Category 3&5 inspection and test performed on an existing elevator. For more information regarding inspection and filing deadlines, please read the rules of the City of New York 1 RCNY 103-02.
