

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Follow-up to Local Law 10 of 2026

Q1. Will the 2-Hour Mental Health Awareness course be required for all SST Worker and Supervisor card renewals?

A1. No, the 2-Hour Mental Health Awareness course is not required for every SST Card renewal option. It is only included in certain SST Card renewal options. The following renewal options remain unchanged:

A2. You may take 2-Hour Mental Health Awareness when completed with either 2-Hour Tool Box Talks or 2-Hour Pre-Task Meeting as part of the following SST renewal options:

Q3. Does the Follow-up affect new SST Worker and Supervisor card options?

A3. No. Local Law 10 of 2026 already requires the 2-Hour Mental Health Awareness course for new SST Worker and Supervisor cards effective August 1, 2026. The Follow-Up to Local Law 10 of 2026 only adds the course to certain SST card renewal options.
