Violations for Failure to Submit Gas Piping System Periodic Inspection Certification for Cycle 2, Sub-cycle A

The NYC Department of Buildings will issue Notices of Violations in January 2026, to owners of all buildings (except for 3-family dwellings) not classified in Occupancy Group R-3 who failed to submit to DOB a Gas Piping System Periodic Inspection Certification (GPS2) for Cycle 2, Sub-cycle A.

The civil penalty for the violation is \$1,500 for a 3-family residential building and \$5,000 for all other buildings. See 1 RCNY §103-10. The civil penalty amount in the Notice of Violation will be based on the Department of Finance's (DOF) Building Classification for the building. If you believe the DOF Building Classification and the resulting penalty amount in the Notice of Violation are incorrect, follow the instructions below to submit a challenge/waiver in **DOB NOW:** *Safety*.

Search Violations & Make Payments

These violations can be searched and viewed in the DOB NOW Public Portal without logging in to DOB NOW. To pay the civil penalty, login to nyc.gov/dobnow using an NYC.ID account and:

- Select the **DOB NOW**: Safety module and then Violations & Notices of Deficiency.
- From the dashboard select +Violations Payments and then Gas Piping LL152.
- Search by violation number, address, BBL, or BIN. Select the violation you want to pay, click **+Add** and then save the application.
- Complete the **Statements & Signature** section and then select **Proceed to Pay** to complete the payment. Only one violation can be paid per application.

Submit a Challenge/Waiver Request

A challenge/waiver request may be submitted within 30 days from the date on the Notice of Violation. To submit a challenge request, login to nyc.gov/dobnow, select the DOB NOW: Safety module and then Violations & Notices of Deficiency. Select +Waivers and Challenges and then Gas Piping – LL152 from the dropdown menu.



One- and Two-Family Homes

One- and two-family residential buildings are not required to comply with **Local Law 152 of 2016**. If your building is a one- or two-family home, go to **nyc.gov/dob** and check the DOF Building Classification on the **Buildings Information System (BIS) Property Profile**. The building classification should be A or B (see example below). If the building classification is anything other than A or B, such as C0, submit an **Exempt Building Notification** by **March 31, 2026**, to avoid receiving a violation.
