New License Application Service Notice – Starting September 7, 2021, all new license applications are required to be submitted online at www.nyc.gov/dobnow. See the New License Application User Guide for step-by-step directions.

The Licensing & Exams Unit will **not** be accepting any walk-in transactions, mailed or emailed submissions for this process.

To obtain an Insurance Tracking Number, provide the **first** and **last** name of the owner and submit the documents via the **DOB NOW Portal**. Applicants that do not currently have an eFiling account will need to create an account by completing the **registration form**.

	<ul> <li>With a tracking number, you are permitted to all work <b>except</b> the following:</li> <li>New Building construction</li> <li>Demolition work</li> </ul>

- Alteration work that adds three or more stories
- Alteration work that removes more than 50% of an existing building's floor area

Vertical or Horizontal alterations that add more than 25% to the floor area of an existing

Work involving the placement of 2,000 cubic yards or more of concrete

Alteration work to remove one or more floors.
