Follow-up #2: HPD CONH Pilot Program Update Prohibition on Professionally Certified Filings New HPD4 Form

Beginning May 30, 2019, the Department will not accept professionally certified filings for Demolition (DM) or Alteration Types 1, 2, and 3 jobs for buildings on the HPD Pilot Program list. These applications must be filed as standard plan examination.

Jobs that are not in 'D' Status (Application Processed-Entire) in the Buildings Information System (BIS) as of May 30, 2019, must be withdrawn and refiled as standard plan examination.

Applicants for plan approval for **covered categories of work**, as defined **in Local Law 1 of 2018**, will be required to submit one of the following documents to a DOB plan examiner:

- Certification of No Harassment (CONH) and a copy of the affidavit submitted to HPD; or
- CONH exemption; or
- Certification of Restrictive Declaration; or
- HPD4: Certificate of No Harassment (CONH) Pilot Program Building: Request for Waiver of Required Item signed and sealed by a licensed design professional. The plan examiner will review this form and the plans to determine whether the work is in a Covered Category of work. If the plan examiner determines that the work is in a Covered Category, and no exception applies, the applicant will be required to obtain and submit a CONH or exemption from HPD prior to plan approval.
