Civil Penalties Increased for Violation of a Stop Work Order (SWO)

Beginning June 18, 2018, the Department will increase the civil penalties for a violation of a Stop Work Order per <u>Local Law 157 of 2017</u>.

Penalty for Violating a Stop Work Order

The civil penalty for failure to comply with a Stop Work Order is increased to \$6,000 for the initial violation and \$12,000 for every subsequent violation, to be paid to the Department prior to the rescission of the Stop Work Order.

Payment of Civil Penalties

 Penalties for failure to comply with a Stop Work Order violation are paid at the Borough Office where the property is located.

Waivers of Increased Civil Penalties

To request a waiver of increased civil penalties, submit an <u>L2 Form</u> (<u>Form</u> Instructions). Eligibility requirements are governed by 1 RCNY Section 102-04.
