Follow Up #1: Local Law 158 of 2017 – Exceptions to the Restriction on Professionally Certified Filings

A new exception to the restriction on professional certification has been added by Local Law 77 of 2023. Filings on buildings with LL158/17 Pro Cert Restrictions in the Property Profile can be professionally certified if the work without a permit was issued to a residential part of the building and the proposed work will be performed on the commercial part of the building. (See Administrative Code § 28-104.2.1)

Submit a Request for an Exception to the Restriction on Professional Certification

For DOB NOW Jobs

Enter the applicable reason for an exception in the Comments field of the PW1 Plan/Work section. The required documentation should be uploaded as LL158/2017 Pro Cert Supporting Documentation. Once payment is made and the Job Filing is submitted for approval, the status bar will reflect the job is in LL 158/2017 Pending Plan Examiner Assignment status. If the request is granted, the application will proceed to Pending Prof Cert QA Assignment. If the request is denied, DOB will notify the applicant and owner by email, and the application must be withdrawn and refiled as Standard Plan Examination or Review.

For BIS Jobs

Submit a **Project Advocate Service Request** form to the borough where the proposed work will occur. In Section 4 of the form, select **Compliance with Local Laws** and **158 of 2017**, provide the address of the proposed work, and enter the applicable exception reason in the space for **Justification**. Provide any additional details in Section 5. Email the completed Service Request form and the required proof to the email address listed at the top of the form.
