[Follow Up #1: 2025 NYC Energy Conservation Code Guidance](#)

Effective March 30, 2026, new job filings, filings with incomplete energy analysis, and projects involving the alteration of a historic building must comply with the 2025 New York City Energy Conservation Code (NYCECC).

Job filings submitted on or after March 30, 2026, must comply with the 2025 NYCECC. Filings submitted prior to March 30, 2026, will also be subject to the 2025 NYCECC if the energy analysis remains incomplete or if the project undergoes a material compliance change after the enforcement date.

Historic Buildings

Historic buildings were previously exempt from energy review when applicants answered 'Yes' to the NYCECC Compliance question, ***Does the work involve the alteration of a historic building as defined in 2025 NYCECC Sections R202 and C202?*** Under the 2025 NYCECC, this exemption no longer applies. Any project involving the alteration of a historic building now requires energy submission. If 'Yes' is answered to the above question a new **Historic Building Report Required Document** will be required to be submitted.
