
SUBJECT: Permits for Bulk Oil, and Gas Storage Tanks

Herewith forwarded is a copy of a memorandum dated June 19, 1973 from Deputy Mayor Hamilton concerning the lifting of the moratorium on issuance of permits for construction of storage facilities for bulk oil, gasoline, and similar liquefied petroleum products (excluding liquefied natural gas facilities, for which the moratorium on issuance of new permits remains in effect).

Based on the attached memorandum, permits for construction of new storage tanks may be issued, provided all applicable law, rules and regulations are complied with, as well as the provisions specified in Deputy Mayor Hamilton's memorandum of June 19, 1973, except with respect to LNG tanks.

Former Commissioner Stein's memorandum dated February 27, 1973 remains in effect with respect to LNG tanks, only.

Further, your attention is directed to the provisions of Local Law 12/73 regarding prohibition of certain types of variances in regard to bulk oil storage facilities, which is not affected by the enclosed memorandum.
