Plumbing, Fire Suppression & Electrical License Boards: Accepting Applications for Members

The Department is seeking electrical and plumbing experts to serve on the 2019 Master Plumbers & Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors License Board, the 2019 Master and Special Electrician License Board, and the Plumbing Operations Committees. The application deadline to be considered for participation is February 8, 2019.

Submission Information & Guidelines

- Applicants must submit a current résumé. Please keep in mind, these are volunteer positions.
- If an applicant wishes to represent an organization, a nomination letter from an officer of the organization **must** be submitted.
- Email applications to PlumbingBdandComm@buildings.nyc.gov. All applications submissions must include the applicant's résumé.

NOTE: Other New York City agencies may review submissions.

REQUIREMENTS: Becoming a Master Plumber & Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractor License Board Member

The PLB is comprised of Licensees from the plumbing, sprinkler, and fire suppression industries, including representatives from the real estate, architectural and engineering communities. The PLB reviews applications for Master Plumber and Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractor licensure. Applicants **must** be nominated by a third-party and belong to at least one of the following organizations:

- Licensed Master Plumber Association of Contracting Plumbers of the City of New York,
 Inc. or the Master Plumber's Council of the City of New York,
 Inc.
- Licensed Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractor (Class A or B) Mechanical Contractors Association of New York, Inc.
- Registered Journeyman Plumber United Association of Plumbers, Local Union 1
- Registered Journeyman Fire Suppression Piping Installer United Association of Steamfitters' Local Union 638
- NYS licensed Professional Engineer with five years' experience in the planning or design and installation of plumbing systems
- NYS Registered Architect
- NYS Professional Engineer with full membership in the Society of Fire Protection Engineers
- Real Estate Owner/Manager or their representative



REQUIREMENTS: Becoming an Electrical License Board Member

Electrical experts with a background in electrical work have opportunities to serve on the Master and Special Electrician License Board. Board members review license applications for compliance with the NYC 2011 Electrical Code Administrative provisions. Board membership is voluntary. Potential Board members should expect to meet at least once a month and **must** satisfy one of the following requirements:

- Licensed Master Electrician actively engaged in the trade
- Journeyman Electrician
- Electrician employed by a Public Service Corporation (utility company) of the City of New York
- NYS licensed Professional Engineer or a NYS Registered Architect with a minimum of five years of experience
- Real Estate Owner/Manager

REQUIREMENTS: Becoming a Plumbing Operations Committee Members

The Plumbing Operations Committee (Sub-Ops) reviews plumbing related technical and operational issues. Potential members **must** be able to meet approximately once a month for four hours. Board membership is voluntary.

The Committee is comprised of individuals from the plumbing, sprinkler, and fire suppression industries, including representatives from the real estate, architectural and engineering communities. Applicants **may** belong to one of the following organizations:

- Licensed Master Plumbers Association of Contracting Plumbers of the City of New York, Inc. and Master Plumber's Council of the City of New York, Inc.
- Licensed Master Fire Suppression Piping Contractors Mechanical Contractors Association of New York, Inc.
- Registered Journeyman Plumbers United Association of Plumbers, Local
- Registered Journeyman Fire Suppression Piping Installers United Association of Steamfitters' Local Union 638
- NYS licensed Professional Engineer
- NYS Registered Architect
- NYS Professional Engineer with full membership in the Society of Fire Protection Engineers
- Real Estate Owner/Manager or their representative
- Utility Company operating in New York State
