

SERVICE UPDATE

Refunds for Permit Fees for One, Two, or Three Family New Buildings and Alteration Applications

Effective January 17, 2017, in accordance with Local Law 56 of 2016, the Department will make several fee changes that affect one, two, or three family dwellings and as a result Applicants/Owners may be eligible for refunds.

Refund Terms and Conditions

- One, two or three family New Buildings and Alteration Applications filed between June 9, 2016 and January 16, 2017 may be eligible for refunds.
- The Department will mail letters to all parties associated with applications affected by the new legislation. The letter will contain refund requirements (listed below) and will instruct applicants on how to obtain refunds.

Refund Requirements

The required documents listed below **must** be submitted to dobrefunds@buildings.nyc.gov by the **original payer**:

- 1. Completed RF1 Refund Request Application
- 2. Proof of payment based on the payment method:
 - Check copy of the cancelled check (front and back)
 - Money Order copy of the money order
 - Credit Card copy of the signed credit card receipt
 - Cash copy of the BIS receipt
 - Online payment copy of the electronic filing payment confirmation receipt
- 3. Copy of the notification letter received from the Department

NOTE: Do not submit any refund requests related to Local Law 56 of 2016 to the borough offices. To prevent delays in processing refund requests, original payer **must** submit all refund requests to dobrefunds @buildings.nyc.gov. FAQs related to Local Law 56 of 2016 are available.
