Follow-Up #4: Extension of Enforcement Moratorium and Temporary Assistance Program for Certain Business Signs

The moratorium on the issuance of certain accessory sign violations, and the temporary assistance program for certain accessory signs have been extended to February 9, 2025. (see [Intro. 886 of 2023](#)) Until that date, the Department of Buildings will not issue violations for business storefront signs that existed before February 9, 2019, are no more than 150 sq. ft. in area or 1,200 pounds, and do not create an imminent threat to public health or safety.
