Because **Current Building Codes don't allow small elevators** in Multiple Dwellings.


So only walk-up buildings that are being gut-renovated can install elevators!

## CREATE A PILOT PROGRAM TO PERMIT SMALL ELEVATORS IN MULTIPLE DWELLINGS

Work with NYC DOB, FDNY, MOPD, disability groups, AARP, installers and US/European Elevator Manufacturers on a Citywide sample building Pilot to test out the initiative. Then Change the Code to Allow Small Elevators in Yards and Courts of Existing Occupied Multi-family Buildings.
