Follow-up #1: Fee and Permit Restriction Waivers for Work to Address Damage Caused by Remnants of Hurricane Ida Expiring on August 31, 2023

Since September 14, 2021, the Department of Buildings has not required applicants to pay fees for filings and permits for work to address damage caused by remnants of Hurricane Ida pursuant to a Mayoral Emergency Executive Order. Permit restrictions have also been waived in connection with such applications.

Fee and permit restriction waivers will expire on August 31, 2023. Filings that were eligible for fee and permit restriction waivers will no longer be eligible for any subsequent filings submitted after August 31, 2023.

A statement has been added to the **Statements & Signatures** section in all DOB NOW: *Build* filings, including Electrical, Limited Alteration Applications and Elevators, for the owner or applicant to certify if the work is due to damage caused by remnants of Hurricane Ida. If 'Yes' is indicated, then all fees for that application will be waived.

Permit Restrictions

The following permit restrictions can be waived in DOB NOW: *Build* by selecting an exception on the permit application that indicates the permit is necessary to perform work to protect public health and safety:

- Local Law 160 of 2017 (Owner Arrears)
- Local Law 104 of 2019 (Multiple Dwellings with Excessive Open Violations)
- Local Law 114 of 2019 (False Statements and Work Without a Permit)
