SUBJECT: Infill Zoning; Special Height Regulations for Developments in Predominantly Built-Up Areas - Section 23-691, Zoning Resolution


Reprints of page 78 of the Zoning Resolution contain a printing error in Section 23-691.

This section should read as follows:

**"Special Height Regulations for Developments
in Predominantly Built-Up Areas**

In the case of development which utilizes the special optional regulations applying to a predominantly built-up area of Section 23-141 in R4 and R5 districts of a zoning lot of not more than 1.5 acres, the maximum height of any portion of a residential building shall not exceed 32 feet. Permitted obstructions that may penetrate a maximum height or sky exposure plane are set forth in Section 23-62 (Permitted Obstruction)."
