NACOLE TO HOST REGIONAL MEETING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CIVILIAN COMPLAINT REVIEW BOARD

NEW YORK – The New York City Civilian Complaint Review Board (CCRB) is proud to partner with the National Association for Civilian Oversight of Law Enforcement (NACOLE) to host the first of two regional meetings in 2025. This event will take place on Tuesday, May 13, 2025, at the New York City College of Technology in Brooklyn.
