NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING**

TO ALL INTERESTED RESIDENTS, GROUPS, COMMUNITY BOARDS, AND AGENCIES:

On Monday, September 14, 2026, the City of New York will release a substantial amendment to its Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for Hurricane Ida Recovery. Through this amendment, the City will detail its proposed use of \$86,000,000 in reallocated CDBG-DR funding provided through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Executive Summaries will be available in English, Spanish, Chinese, Russian, Bengali, Haitian, Korean, Arabic, Urdu, French, and Polish. The substantial amendment is subject to a 30-day public comment period, which will begin on September 15, 2026. Comments must be received no later than Friday, October 16, 2026 at 11:59 P.M. (EST). Written comments may be submitted to CDBGComments@omb.nyc.gov or to the Mayor's Office of Management and Budget (OMB), Attention: Evan Pellegrino, Director of Community Development, 255 Greenwich Street, 8th Floor, New York, New York 10007.

A hearing is scheduled for October 8, 2026 from 6:00-7:00pm to obtain comments on the City's use of federal funds. The hearing may be attended either in person or virtually. Information for attending the hearing virtually or in person is below:
