Re: COIB Rule 1-13(e)(1): Designation of BXDA employee Adrienne Giunta to Perform Work with Not-for Profit Entity

Dear Mr. Carrier:

Pursuant to Rule 1-13(e)(1) of the Rules of the Conflict of Interest Board (“COIB”) I write to disclose that Adrienne Giunta, Deputy Chief for the Special Victims Division of the Bronx District Attorney’s Office (“BXDA”) has been invited to serve as a board member for the New York State Children’s Alliance (NYSCA), effective January 1, 2026. Previously, I notified COIB of Chief Joseph Muroff’s designation for this role on November 1, 2019. Chief Muroff’s term, which commenced on January 1, 2020, will conclude on December 31, 2025.

The NYSCA is a non-profit organization whose mission is to promote the development, growth, and continuation of multidisciplinary teams and child advocacy centers throughout New York State in order to play a crucial role in providing healing and justice to abused and neglected children and their families.

Deputy Chief Giunta possesses a wealth of experience gained over the course of over two decades of public service. She routinely oversees, manages, and actively participates in special victims, domestic violence, and child safety awareness work. In her role at BXDA, Deputy Chief Giunta is part of several multi-disciplinary teams where professionals from different backgrounds and perspectives join together and collaborate on projects squarely aimed at serving vulnerable communities. For NYSCA, she would attend monthly virtual one hour board/committee meetings, and twice a year in person upstate meetings/conferences in the Albany area or Syracuse, New York. She is not involved in any business dealings between NYSCA and the City, should such business dealings exist

Accordingly, I believe Deputy Chief Giunta possesses the expertise and skills to take on this role on behalf of the BXDA and that doing so would be in the City’s interest.
