

Settlement Fund Claim Form –Booting by B&M Electronic Diagnostic Repair Service Inc and NY Booting LLC at Multiple Parking Lots

Under NYC law, companies that place wheel locks (boots) on illegally parked cars in private parking lots cannot charge more than \$25 to remove boots. In settlements with the NYC Department of Consumer and Worker Protection (DCWP), the private companies who contracted with B&M Electronic Diagnostic Repair Service Inc. or NY Booting LLC agreed to refund money to eligible consumers who had their vehicles booted in multiple parking lots in Brooklyn and Queens.

You may be eligible for a refund if:

- Your vehicle was booted at one of the parking lots listed below, AND
- You were charged more than \$25 by B&M Electronic Diagnostic Repair Service Inc. or NY Booting to remove the boot.

Instructions:

This form includes three sections (I-III). You must complete each section. Submit the completed form and any supporting documents to DCWP in ONE of the following ways:

DCWP will review claims in the order it receives them. DCWP will pay refunds until no money remains in the Settlement Fund or the submission deadline, whichever comes first. **The deadline to submit a claim is March 17, 2025.**
