

Settlement Fund Claim Form

Under NYC law, companies that place wheel locks (boots) on illegally parked cars in private parking lots cannot charge more than \$25 to remove boots. If you were booted by B & M Electronic Diagnostic Repair Service Inc. d/b/a B & M Towing Inc. (DCWP license number 0929938-DCA), B & M Electronic Diagnostic Repair Service Inc. (DCWP license number 2084752-DCA), or NY Booting (DCWP license number 2098438- DCA) at one of the following Home Depot stores in 2021 or 2022, and you were charged more than \$25, you were charged an incorrect amount and may be entitled to a refund.

The deadline to submit a claim is July 19, 2023.

This form includes three sections (I-III). You must complete each section. Submit the completed form and any supporting documents to DCWP in ONE of the following ways:

DCWP will review claims in the order it receives them. DCWP will pay refunds until no money remains in the Settlement Fund or the submission deadline, whichever comes first.
