The Commissioner of the Department of Citywide Administrative Services has scheduled a virtual public hearing to be held on August 19, 2020, at 10:00AM on WebEx Event Center, to consider a proposal to make Clerical Associate (10251), Open Competitive, Exam No. 8003 eligible list appropriate for filling positions in the title of Secretary (10252). Clerical Associate (10251) and Secretary (10252) both require a four-year high school diploma. Although Clerical Associate requires one year of clerical experience, there are similarities amongst the duties and responsibilities of both titles. Clerical Associate (10251) and Secretary (10252) are both represented by District Council 37, Collective Bargaining Unit [128] – Clerical Titles; and the new hire rate for both titles are the same.

As such, DCAS recommends making the Clerical Associate (10251), Open Competitive civil service list Exam No. 8003 appropriate for filling positions in the title of Secretary (10252). The names of eligibles who accept an appointment as Secretary will remain on the list for Clerical Associate (10251), Exam No. 8003. This option will allow agencies to fill their vacancies and candidates will benefit by being hired into city service more quickly than they otherwise would.
