CHIEF PENSION INVESTMENT ADVISOR, FINANCE (MOPI)

Under the Executive direction of the Mayor and the Commissioner of Finance, with very broad scope for the exercise of independent initiative and judgment, serves as the administration's full-time, central advisor to the Mayor's trustees on the five New York City retirement system boards and on the New York City Deferred Compensation Plan Board; works with the Office of the Comptroller to monitor and advise on the performance of investments and investment managers for all asset classes held by the pension systems and Deferred Compensation Plan.
