DEPUTY COMMISSIONER (DOT)

General Statement of Duties and Responsibilities

This is a management class of positions.

Under administrative direction of the Commissioner or the First Deputy Commissioner, with full latitude for the exercise of independent initiative and judgment, has primary responsibility for the activities of a major division of the Department of Transportation (DOT).

Participates in the formulation and implementation of the agency or division policies and recommends changes in policies and procedures as deemed necessary. Develops and implements division strategic plans ensuring consistency with the agency's mission.

Directs the work of executive, managerial, professional, technical and support staff responsible for the operations of the division, including the establishment of short and long term plans, setting goals, objectives and priorities, allocating resources, including personnel, for the most effective utilization, and establishing and maintaining organizational controls. Coordinates the activities of the division with other organizational units within the agency, as necessary.

Represents the Commissioner at meetings and conferences concerning policy and operational issues and agency activities. Performs liaison functions relating to the operations of the agency with federal, State, and City agencies.

Qualification Requirements

- 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college and 4 years of satisfactory experience of a nature to qualify for the duties and responsibilities of the position, at least 18 months of which must have been in an administrative, managerial, consultative or executive capacity or supervising personnel performing activities related to the duties of the position; or
- 2. A combination of education and/or experience equivalent to "1" above. However, all candidates must have the 18 months of administrative, managerial, executive, consultative or supervisory experience described in "1" above.
