<u>Correction Officer</u>—Accepting Applications Through 9/27

Correction Officers, under supervision, maintain security and are responsible for the care, custody, control, job training and work performance of sentenced and detained inmates within New York City correctional facilities.

## **Special Officer—Accepting Applications Through 8/27**

Special Officers under supervision, perform Special Officer work of ordinary difficulty and responsibility relating to physical security, safety, loss prevention and maintenance of order. They patrol designated areas of public buildings, other facilities, and surrounding areas to maintain order, preserve the peace, and safeguard life and property against fire, vandalism, theft, etc.

## <u>Special Officer (NYC H+H)</u>—Accepting Applications Through 8/27

Special Officers (For NYC Health + Hospitals only), under supervision, perform Special Officer (For NYC Health + Hospitals only) work of ordinary difficulty and responsibility relating to physical security, safety, loss prevention and maintenance of order. They patrol designated areas of public buildings, other facilities, and surrounding areas to maintain order, preserve the peace, and safeguard life and property against fire, vandalism, theft, etc.

## <u>Traffic Enforcement Agent</u> —Accepting Applications Through 10/11

At Assignment Level I, under supervision, Traffic Enforcement Agents patrol an assigned area to enforce laws, rules and regulations relating to movement, parking, stopping, and standing of vehicles.
