- Deadlines for submitting school confirmations to MGSP that school application(s) have been received by the school(s)

IMPORTANT POINTS:

- 1. You must submit copies of school confirmations that the school(s) of your choice has received your application to the Mayor's Graduate Scholarship Program application will not be forwarded to the school(s), unless the indicated document has been received by our office by the deadlines indicated in the Application Deadlines column on each school's offering. To verify your school application submission, you may send a copy of your online confirmation page, acceptance letter/email from the admissions office or cancelled check. Some schools offer other scholarships at various dollar amounts that cannot be combined with the MGSP award, unless approved by the school.
