An application submitted by the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State, to designate three properties, at 1559-1563 Prospect Place as an Urban Development Action Area, and an Urban Development Action Area Project (UDAAP), and, pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter for the disposition of this site to a developer selected by HPD. Such actions would facilitate the development of an eight-story building with approximately 44 affordable housing units, with a percentage reserved for the formerly homeless, in Brooklyn Community District 8 (CD 8).

An application submitted by the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State to designate the following 13 properties as an Urban Development Action Area (UDAA) and an Urban Development Action Area Project (UDAAP): 421-423 Herkimer Street, 440-444 Herkimer Street, 816 Herkimer Street, 329-331 Ralph Avenue, 335 Ralph Avenue, 35-37 Rochester Avenue, and 18-22 Suydam Place, and, pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter for the disposition of this site to a developer selected by HPD. Such actions would facilitate the construction of seven new buildings with a total of approximately 78 affordable homeownership units in Brooklyn Community District 3 (CD 3).

Calendar Item 3 — 50 Old Fulton Rezoning (190011 ZMK)

An application submitted by Alwest Old Fulton, LLC, pursuant to Sections 197-c and 201 of the New York City Charter, for a zoning map amendment to change the eastern portion of a block, bounded by Doughty Street, Elizabeth Place, Hicks Street, and Old Fulton Street, from M2-1 to M1-5. Such action would facilitate the development of an approximately 39,000 square foot, five-story commercial building with retail stores occupying the cellar, ground, and second floors, as well as office space on the floors above in Brooklyn Community District 2 (CD 2).

Calendar Item 4 — 90 Sands Street Rezoning (200059 ZMK, 200060 ZRK)

An application submitted by 90 Sands Housing Development Fund Corporation, pursuant to Sections 197-c and 201 of the New York City

Charter for the following actions: A zoning map amendment to change the block, bounded by Jay, High, Pearl, and Sands streets from M1-6 to M1-6/R10, and establish an MX-2 Special Mixed Use District, a zoning text amendment to designate the site a Mandatory Inclusionary Housing (MIH) area, and a further text change to amend the effective date of the existing MX-2 District in the DUMBO neighborhood of Brooklyn Community District 2 (CD 2). Such actions would facilitate the conversion of an existing building to a facility containing 305 supportive housing units, and 202 affordable housing units targeted to households earning 30 to 100 percent of Area Median Income (AMI). The redevelopment would provide space for community facility, commercial, or light manufacturing use in its lower cellar, and renovate an existing gated plaza that would be opened for public use.

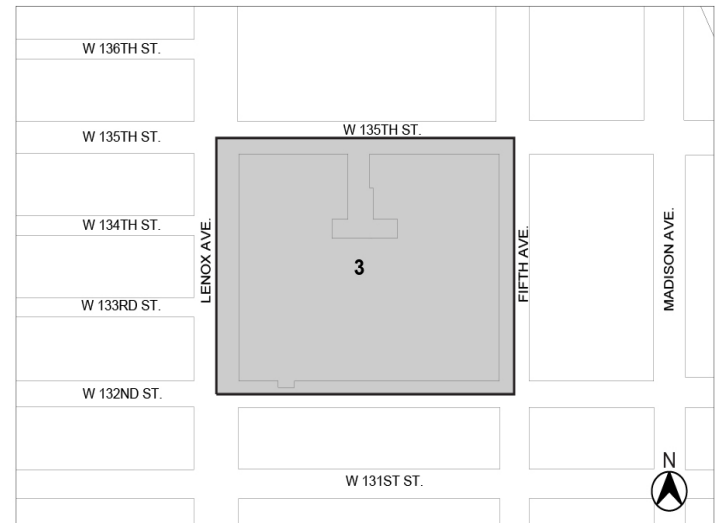

This proposed rule was not included in the Conflicts of Interest Board’s regulatory agenda for this Fiscal Year because it was not contemplated when the Conflicts of Interest Board published the agenda.

Where can I find the Conflicts of Interest Board’s rules? The Conflicts of Interest Board’s rules are in Title 53 of the Rules of the City of New York.

What rules govern the rulemaking process? The Conflicts of Interest Board must meet the requirements of Section 1043 of the City Charter when creating or changing rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of Section 1043 of the City Charter.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rule

Chapter 9 of Title 3 of the New York City Administrative Code (“Chapter 9”) regulates not-for-profit organizations affiliated with elected officials by, among other things, requiring such organizations to report certain donations. Local Law 153 of 2019 amended Chapter 9 by:

- (1) clarifying that a donor’s donations are aggregated throughout the calendar year to trigger the donation reporting thresholds;
- (2) relaxing the reporting requirements on unrestricted organizations (as defined in Board Rules § 3-01(k)); and
- (3) permitting donors to unrestricted organizations to request anonymity from the organizations themselves instead of the unrestricted organizations requesting permission from the Conflicts of Interest Board to offer their donors anonymity when reporting their donations.

The proposed amendments to Board Rules § 3-04 would implement these legislative changes and omit duplicative rule language that is now contained in Chapter 9.

Text of the Proposed Rule

New material is underlined.

[Deleted material is in brackets.]

Section 3-04 of Title 53 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 3-04. Annual Reporting by Organizations Affiliated with an Elected Official.

Pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-902, all organizations affiliated with an elected official must submit the reporting required pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-902(a) on the Board’s website, no later than August 1 for the previous calendar year, as follows.

- (a) *Reporting Requirements for Restricted Organizations*

* * *

- (2) [To comply with] In addition to the reporting requirements of Administrative Code §§ 3-902(a)(6) and 3-902(a)(7), a restricted organization must report for each donation received during the previous calendar year:
 - (i) the name of any donor who, as of the date of such donation, was either listed in the City’s Doing Business Database or who was a household member of a person listed in the City’s Doing Business Database;
 - (ii) the name of any donor who was added to the City’s Doing Business Database within 180 days after the receipt of such donation or who was a household member of a person added to the City’s Doing Business Database within 180 days after receipt of such donation;
 - (iii) (i) if the donor was the household member of a person listed in the City’s Doing Business Database as of the date of such donation, or added to the City’s Doing Business Database within 180 days after the receipt of such donation, the name of the person listed in the City’s Doing Business Database;
 - (iv) the name of any donor who made a donation with a reasonable value of \$1,000 or more;
 - (v) the city and state of residence of the donor;
 - (vi) the date of each donation;

- (vii) the value of each donation;
- (viii) (ii) the value of any excess donation refunded pursuant to Administrative Code §§ 3-903(a) or 3-903(b); and
- (ix)(iii) the date of any excess donation refunded pursuant to Administrative Code §§ 3-903(a) or 3-903(b).

(3) Multiple donations made by a person listed in the City's Doing Business Database and that person's household members in the same calendar year are considered in the aggregate for purposes of Administrative Code §§ 3-903(a), and 3-903(b). Multiple donations made by an individual in the same calendar year are considered in the aggregate [for purposes of Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(7) and] for purposes of obtaining the individual donor's written submission pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-903(d).

(b) *Reporting Requirements for Unrestricted Organizations.*

[1] An unrestricted organization must submit the information listed in Administrative Code §§ 3-902[(a)(1) to (a)(9)] (b)(1) to (b)(8).

[2] To comply with the reporting requirement of Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(6), an unrestricted organization must take the following steps to determine whether a donor was listed in the City's Doing Business Database or was a household member of a person listed in the City's Doing Business Database, either on the date of the donation or within 180 days after the date of the donation:

- (i) check the name of the donor against the City's Doing Business Database both at the time of the donation and as of 180 days after the date of the donation;
- (ii) consult the organization's records, including but not limited to donors' written submissions collected pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-903(d), to determine whether the donor was a household member of a person listed in the City's Doing Business Database; and
- (iii) if an organization believes that a donor, a donor's spouse or domestic partner (or, if a donor is an unemancipated child, his or her parent), is not a person with business dealings with the City, despite such person's name matching the name of an individual in the Doing Business Database, the organization must submit information supporting that conclusion to the Board. The Board will review the submission and determine whether the donation must be reported pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(6).

(3) To comply with the reporting requirement of Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(7), an unrestricted organization must submit to the Board the names of any individuals who or entities that made a donation with a reasonable value of \$1,000 or more, whether in a single donation or in multiple donations. If an unrestricted organization receives multiple donations from the same individual or entity, the aggregate value of which has a reasonable value of \$1,000 or more, the organization must report the date and value of every donation from that individual or entity.

(4) To comply with the reporting requirement of Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(8), an unrestricted organization must submit to the Board a list of each elected official communication created or distributed, which list must include a description, the date, and the total cost of each such communication. In calculating the total cost of an elected official communication, an unrestricted organization must include the value of all goods and services paid by the organization to create and distribute the elected official communication, including without limitation the value of the time of its employees and the value of all goods and services donated by a non-governmental source for the communication's creation or distribution.

(5) To comply with the reporting requirement of Administrative Code § 3-902(a)(9), an unrestricted

organization must report its total expenditures for the previous calendar year and, for the current calendar year, both total budgeted expenditures and budgeted expenditures for elected official communications.]

(c) *Privacy, Safety, and Security Requests*

(1) Pursuant to Administrative Code § 3-902[(b)(c)], [an] a restricted organization [affiliated with an elected official] may submit a request to the Board that disclosure of one or more of its donors and/or the amount of donation not be made public. The organization must make such a request in writing no later than April 1 for the previous calendar year and must explain why the release of such information to the public may cause harm, threats, harassment, or reprisals to the donor, or to individuals or property affiliated with the donor.

Notice of Adoption to amend the rules relating to second-hand automobile dealers to clarify that records maintained electronically in compliance with recent New York State Department of Motor Vehicle regulations comply with the record keeping requirements of the New York City Administrative Code.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN the Commissioner of Consumer Affairs by Sections 1043 and 2203(f) of the New York City Charter, and Sections 20-104(b) and 20-275.1 of the New York City Administrative Code, and in accordance with the requirements of Section 1043 of the New York City Charter, that the Department amends Section 2-109 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York.

This rule was proposed and published on September 25, 2019. A public hearing was held on October 25, 2019.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Rule

DCA is amending Section 2-109 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York relating to the record keeping requirements for secondhand automobile dealers.

Recently, the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles issued a new regulation that requires automobile dealers, absent limited exceptions, to use an electronic recordkeeping system called the Vehicle Electronic Reassignment and Integrated Facility Inventory ("VERIFI"). See 15 NYCRR 78.9. Under New York City law, secondhand automobile dealers must maintain written records of all transactions with specific information such as a description of the automobile purchased or sold and name and address of the buyer or seller. See NYC Admin. Code § 20-273.

DCA is amending its rule to clarify that a record maintained by a dealer in the VERIFI system satisfies the requirements of Section 20-273 of the New York City Administrative Code if it contains the information required by Section 20-273. In other words, this amendment makes clear that secondhand automobile dealers need not maintain separate records to comply with the New York State VERIFI requirements and the New York City Administrative Code requirements.

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Rule Amendment

Section 2-109 of Subchapter K of Chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

§ 2-109 Records and Reports.

(a) To comply with Section 20-268.5(a) of the Administrative Code, a second-hand automobile dealer must maintain a copy of the consumer bill of rights signed or initialed by each consumer for six years after the date of execution of such document.

(b) To comply with Section 20-268.5(c) of the Administrative Code, a second-hand automobile dealer must maintain an automobile contract cancellation option report in the format shown below.

(c) A second-hand automobile dealer shall be in violation of Section 20-268.5(c) of the Administrative Code for failing to make available a copy of its automobile contract cancellation option report to the commissioner within 20 business days of receiving a request. Notwithstanding the foregoing sentence, a second-hand automobile dealer shall not be in violation of Section 20-268.5(c) for such a failure where he or she received and complied with a similar request in the past 12 months.

(d) Records maintained by a second-hand automobile dealer in a manner compliant with the Vehicle Electronic Reassignment and Integrated Facility Inventory (VERIFI) system pursuant to Title 15, Part 78.9 of the Code, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York satisfy the requirements of Section 20-273 of the Administrative Code if the records contain the information required by such section of the Administrative Code. Nothing in this subdivision affects a second-hand automobile dealer's obligation to fully comply with Sections 20-273(e) and 20-273(f) of the Administrative Code.

- 1. The public use and benefit of this project is for the reconstruction of storm and sanitary sewers and related work in the Borough of Staten Island (the "Project").
2. The properties to be acquired are within the acquisition limits shown on Damage and Acquisition Map No. 4250 as follows:
- The bed of West Castor Place from Alverson Avenue to Powell Street, McBaine Avenue from Alverson Avenue to approximately 200 feet west of Alverson Avenue, Alverson Avenue from Woodrow Road to Correl Avenue, and Gilroy Street from Woodrow Road to West Castor Place.

The Blocks and Lots affected include the following locations, as shown on the Tax Map of the City of New York for the Borough of Staten Island:

The City selected these locations based on a need for the installation of storm and sanitary sewers in the area of West Castor Place, McBaine Avenue, Alverson Avenue and Gilroy Street. The general effect on the neighborhood will be to improve current living conditions.

An environmental assessment of the proposed property acquisition location was conducted in accordance with the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR) and the New York City Environmental Quality Review process (CEQR). The New York City Department of Environmental Protection, as lead agency, determined that the proposed project would have no new or different significant environmental impacts, and issued a Technical Memorandum to the Environmental Impact Statement (CEQR No. 97DEP026R) on July 17, 2019.

Comments and concerns presented, at the public hearing and through subsequent written submissions have been reviewed by the City. Questions were raised by property owners regarding the acquisition and project boundaries, and the manner in which adjacent properties would be affected. Property owners also requested that DEP expands the current project boundary to include Alverson Loop, a privately-owned street.

The City will work with all public and private parties involved in the project to minimize the impact of construction activities on the street, residents and environment, and will work with other involved agencies and the community in order to review and address project-related concerns. The City continues to review its design plans and will make modifications addressing any issues whenever possible.

The City has also reviewed all potential alternate locations and has determined that no other sites are feasible for the Project.

DETERMINATION:

Based upon due consideration of the record and the foregoing findings, it is determined that the City of New York should exercise its power of eminent domain to acquire the above-described properties in order to promote and permit the purposes of the Project to be achieved.

NOTICE:

Pursuant to EDPL Section 207, property owners have thirty (30) days from completion of the publication of this "Determination and Findings" to seek judicial review of this determination. This publication will be advertised in the City Record and Staten Island Advance newspapers.

The exclusive venue for the judicial review of this determination, pursuant to EDPL Sections 207 and 208 is the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court in the Judicial Department where any part of the property to be acquired is located.
