The proposed reconstruction of Third Street Playground in Prospect Park includes new play equipment and imaginative play elements for 2-12 year olds, new tot swings and tire swings, water play features, and code-compliant recycled rubber safety surfacing and concrete pavements. Tropical hardwood from the current design will be repurposed as wood decking at the surface level with three new tree pits to introduce much needed shade into the center of the playground. Ground play, such as play panels and rustic playhouses, introduce new opportunities for open-ended and creative play for children of varied ages and abilities. The board will vote to issue a recommendation to New York City Landmarks and Preservation Commission (LPC) and Public Design Commission (PDC).









On Wednesday, November 6, 2024, a public hearing is being held by the City Planning Commission (CPC), accessible inperson and remotely, in conjunction with the above ULURP hearing to receive comments related to a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) concerning an application by The New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC), the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), and the New York City Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS) (collectively, the Applicants), in affiliation with the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation (H+H), New York City Public Schools (NYCPS), the New York City School Construction Authority (SCA), and the City University of New York (CUNY). The Applicants are seeking a series of land use actions including a zoning map amendment; a zoning text amendment to Appendix F of the New York City Zoning Resolution (ZR); special permits pursuant to ZR Section 74 171 and 75-901; Dispositions, acquisitions, and site selections; and a City Map Change related to the demapping of the East 25th Street replacement bridge (the "Proposed Actions") from the City Planning Commission. The area subject to the Proposed Actions is generally bounded by East 25th Street to the south, First Avenue to the west, FDR Drive to the east, and the northern edge of the former East 26th Street, and encompasses the southern, approximately 4.75-acre portion of Manhattan Block 962, Lot 100 (the Development Site) located at 425 East 25th Street in the Kips Bay area of Manhattan Community District 6. The Proposed Actions, along with other discretionary approvals, would facilitate the development of the Science Park and Research Campus (SPARC) Kips Bay project, which would transform Hunter College's antiquated Brookdale Campus into approximately 2.19 million gross square feet (gsf) of state-of-the-art academic, healthcare, and life sciences and retail space and public realm improvements (the Proposed Project).

The proposed project would also require other discretionary approvals including the use of City capital funding to construct the new CUNY building, New York State financing for the development of the proposed project, and the siting of CUNY and NYCPS facilities, which are not subject to ULURP. The Build Year is 2031.

Statement of Basis and Purpose of Proposed Rule

The Department of Buildings is amending section 9.5.1.2 of National Fire Protection Association ("NFPA") standard 715, as amended by section 3616-06 of chapter 3600 of Title 1 of the Rules of the City of New York, to extend the deadline for allowing installation of a monitored battery primary power source for natural gas alarms in existing buildings.

The proposed rule amendment would allow any building completed by January 1, 2025 to install a monitored battery primary power source for their natural gas alarm. When the rule was originally promulgated, it allowed battery units to be installed in existing buildings constructed by January 1, 2024 in accordance with the provisions of Local Law 157 of 2016. However, there were many buildings that were not completed by January 1, 2024 but had not been designed for wired units and were too far into the construction process to accommodate them at that point. Extending the cutoff date to January 1, 2025 would allow those buildings currently under construction to be deemed "existing" and therefore be able to choose to install the battery-powered units. Other

buildings still in the early stages of construction should be able to accommodate the hardwired units and are required to do so.

In addition, the hard-wired units that meet the required listing criteria may currently be difficult to obtain. Therefore, the allowance for battery powered systems is being extended from January 1, 2024 to January 1, 2025.

The language of paragraphs (1) and (2) of NFPA section 9.5.1.2 in section 3616-06 is being amended to match the changes to the language made in paragraph (3) of that section.

The Department of Buildings' authority for this rule is found in sections 643 and 1043 of the New York City Charter and Local Law 157 of 2016.

9.5.1.2 Delete and replace with the following: Electrically powered fuel gas warning equipment must be provided with a primary ac power source in accordance with 9.5.2.1 and a secondary power source in accordance with 9.5.4, unless otherwise permitted by the following:

(1) Detectors [must be permitted to] <u>may</u> be powered by a monitored dc circuit of a control unit where power for the control unit meets the requirements of Section 9.5 and the circuit remains operable upon loss of primary ac power.

(2) A detector and a wireless transmitter that serves only that detector [must be permitted to] <u>may</u> be powered from a monitored battery primary source where part of a listed, monitored, low-power radio wireless system.

(3) A monitored battery primary power source in accordance with 9.5.3 [must be permitted] <u>may be installed</u> in existing buildings, as defined in section 28-101.5 of the Administrative Code, that were [constructed] <u>completed</u> before January 1, [2024] <u>2025</u>.

Statement of Basis and Purpose

The Department is amending the rules for the subsidized grocery delivery program, called the Groceries to Go Program ("Program").

The Program was established to provide eligible Health and Hospital NYC Care members with diabetes or hypertension, and who are at risk for food insecurity, with money to purchase groceries through an online marketplace of local grocery stores. Due to the high rates of food insecurity in New York City and the overwhelming demand for the Program, the Department proposes several changes to Chapter 34 to reach more New Yorkers experiencing food insecurity. As of October 16, 2024, over 2,150 New Yorkers are on a waiting list for the Program. Without the rule change, the Department will not be able to enroll any new participants for the remainder of the City's fiscal year 2025.

First, the Department proposes requiring households seeking to enroll in the Program to self-report experiencing food insecurity¹, instead of a self-report of risk for food insecurity. Research shows that food insecurity may exacerbate outcomes related to diet-related chronic diseases,² including diabetes and hypertension, making New Yorkers with food insecurity and these conditions a high priority population for food support programs like Groceries to Go. Thus, when screening for program eligibility, the Department will stop using questions validated to identify people at risk for food insecurity³ and instead use questions validated to identify individuals experiencing food insecurity. ⁴ This change will allow the Groceries to Go Program to reach eligible New Yorkers with the greatest need for monthly credits to purchase groceries. The amended definition used for food insecurity is based on the definition used by the United States Department of Agriculture for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

Additionally, the Department proposes amending the rule to change the reasons for removal from the Groceries to Go Program. The Department proposes to remove participants after three months of program inactivity, instead of after six months. The Department also proposes limiting program participation to a maximum of 18 cumulative months. Individuals removed following 18 cumulative months of participation would be assessed for eligibility to re-enroll in the program following a period of 18 or more months off the program. If the program is full at the conclusion of the 18-month or longer period after such an individual was removed from the program, that individual could join a waitlist. The Department proposes these

changes so the Program can enroll more eligible New Yorkers in need of credits to purchase groceries.

The Department is also aligning the number of program credits participating households receive to better reflect how the program is currently operating. Participating households with one to two people will receive \$110 per month and those with three or more people will receive \$270 per month. All participants receive a 50% discount, up to \$30 per month in savings, on purchases of fresh fruits and vegetables using their program credits. The \$30 per month in savings were previously named as credits received by participants but in practice, they are part of a separate discount and are not always fully utilized by participants.

Finally, the Department proposes limiting the number of credits participants can hold in their Groceries to Go accounts to three months' worth of credits. Under the proposed amendments to the rule, program participants would receive between \$0 and \$110 per month for households of one or two people and between \$0 and \$270 per month for households of three or more people, depending on the number of unused credits banked in their accounts. Limiting the number of credits that participants can carry would increase the Department's ability to accommodate additional participants.

- [(3) Received food from a food pantry].

The term "household" means everyone who lives at the same address.

The term "Program" means the Groceries to Go Program described in this section.

\$ 3. Subdivision (c) of section 34-01 of chapter 34 of Title 24 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(c) *Eligibility criteria*. Only one [person] <u>individual</u> per household may be enrolled in the Program at any time. The Program will not accept applications from more than one [person] <u>individual</u> at the same address. The Program will only be available to individuals that meet all of the following eligibility criteria:

(i) The individual is a Health and Hospitals New York City Care Member;

(ii) The individual reports diagnosis of hypertension or diabetes;

(iii) The individual reports [a risk for] <u>having household</u> food insecurity; [and]

(iv) The individual is a New York City resident[.]; and

(v) For individuals removed from the Program after 18 cumulative months of Program participation, at least 18 months have elapsed following such individual's removal.

\$ 4. Subdivision (d) of section 34-01 of chapter 34 of Title 24 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:

(d) *Program credits*. Program credits will be allocated as follows:

(i) A household of one or two people will receive [\$140] <u>\$110</u> per month, or the maximum portion thereof that would bring such household's <u>Program account balance up to a maximum of \$330;</u> (ii) A household of three or more people will receive [\$300] <u>\$270</u> per month, or the maximum portion thereof that would bring such household's Program account balance up to a maximum of <u>\$810</u>;

What rules govern the rulemaking process? DHS must meet the requirements of section 1043 of the City Charter when creating or changing rules. This notice is made according to the requirements of section 1043(b) of the City Charter.

Statement of Basis and Purpose

In 2019, the New York State Senate introduced legislation (S.7215-A), which proposed to amend section 21-324 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York ("Administrative Code") to require the New York City Department of Homeless Services ("DHS" or "the Department") to conduct a public hearing in the community district where a proposed new homeless shelter is to be located before being sited. The purpose of the legislation was to promote accountability and transparency by allowing interested community members and elected officials to voice concerns, including about public safety, transportation and educational accessibility, regarding a proposed homeless shelter. The bill was signed into law and became Chapter 383 of the Laws of 2020.

However, Chapter 68 of the Laws of 2021 further amended section 21-324 to require public information sessions rather than public hearings because a public hearing requirement could cause unnecessary delays in the shelter siting process. Public information sessions will continue to provide the public the opportunity to raise questions and concerns to DHS about proposed homeless shelters and their locations without causing unnecessary delays.

Section 21-324, as amended, imposes several requirements on DHS. First, it requires DHS to "establish a process for the notification of new homeless shelters," which must include notice to local elected officials and the community board in which the shelter is to be sited. Second, it requires that annual notices be sent to federal, state, and local elected officials seeking potential locations for future shelter. Lastly, it requires DHS to "conduct at least one public information session on the siting of any new homeless shelter" in the community district where such shelter is to be located, and to post the time and location of such information session no later than fourteen days before such session occurs.

To accomplish this mandate, DHS proposes to establish a new Chapter 6 within Title 31 of the Rules of the City of New York ("RCNY") to implement notification and public information procedures for new homeless shelters.

The Department's authority for this proposed rule is found in sections 389, 612, and 1043 of the Charter, and section 21-324 of the Administrative Code.

"Shall" and "must" denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of the Department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

Section 1. Title 31 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended by adding a new chapter six to read as follows:

<u>Chapter 6: Publication of Information Regarding New</u> <u>Homeless Shelters</u>

<u>§ 6-01. Definitions. As used in this chapter, the following terms</u> <u>have the following meanings:</u>

(a) "Conduct" means directing, controlling, orchestrating, hosting, coordinating, or participating in a public information session.

(b) "Department" means the New York city department of homeless services.

(c) "New homeless shelter" means a facility that has not previously been operated by the department as a shelter.

(d) "Public information session" means an in-person or a virtual or remote meeting, conference, assembly, or other gathering attended by department staff and open to the public.

(e) "Shelter" means any facility established and operated for the purpose of providing temporary residential care, to homeless adults, adult families, or families with children by the department or by a provider under contract or similar agreement with the department applying for or in receipt of temporary housing assistance.

(f) "Emergency homeless shelter" means any facility with overnight sleeping accommodations, the primary purpose of which is to provide temporary shelter to recipients of temporary housing assistance and opened during a state of emergency declared by the Mayor pursuant to section 24 of the Executive Law or by the Governor pursuant to section 28 of such law, or pursuant to an emergency procurement. § 6-02. Process for Notification of a New Homeless Shelter.

(a) After it has identified a proposed new homeless shelter, but before registering with the city comptroller a contract to operate such shelter, the department will:

(1) Provide written notice to all federal, state, and local elected officials, as well as to the community board of the community district in which the proposed new homeless shelter is to be located, informing them of such a facility and of the department's intention to site a shelter at the facility. Such notice will include:

(i) the location of the proposed new homeless shelter;

(ii) the capacity of the proposed new homeless shelter;

(iii) the population the proposed new homeless shelter will serve;

(iv) the name of the provider selected to operate the proposed new homeless shelter, if any; and

 $\underline{(v)}$ the anticipated opening date of the proposed new homeless shelter; and

(2) Conduct at least one public information session at which members of the public may ask questions and make comments in the community district in which the proposed new homeless shelter is to be sited:

(3) Post on the department's website the date, time, and location of or weblink to such public information session, as well as the address of the proposed new homeless shelter, no less than 14 days before such session is scheduled to occur; and

(4) Accept written questions and comments on the proposal to site a new homeless shelter within 14 days of such public information session.

(b) The procedures in this section do not apply to emergency homeless shelters, provided however, that in the event an emergency homeless shelter will operate beyond the duration of the state of emergency pursuant to which it was established, the department will comply with the notification requirements described in this section before registering with the city comptroller any contract or agreement to operate a shelter at the same site.

(c) No later than March 31 of each calendar year, the department will send written notice, electronically and by mail, to all federal, state, and local elected officials requesting that such officials identify potential locations for new shelters in their districts.
