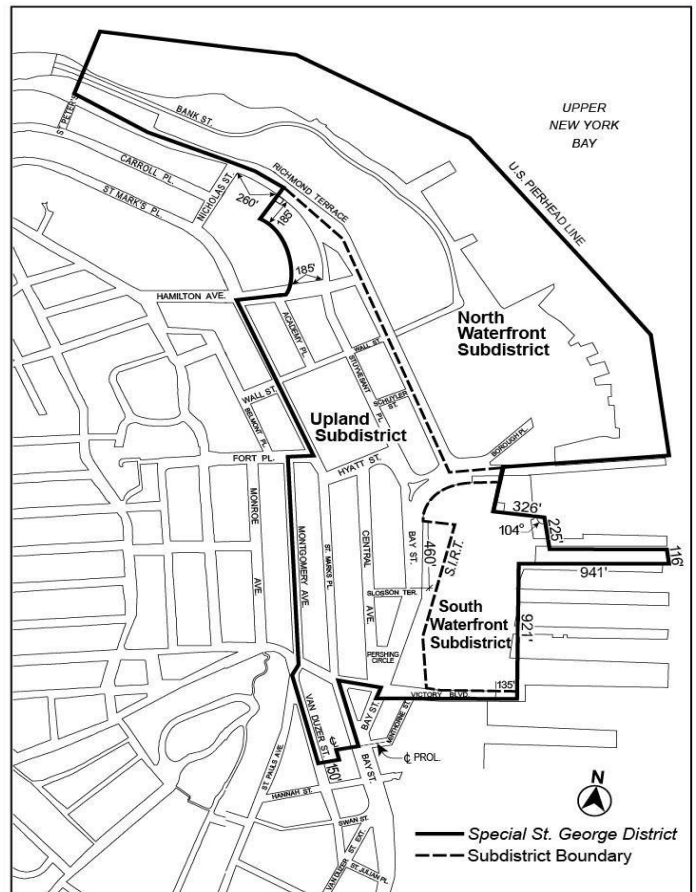

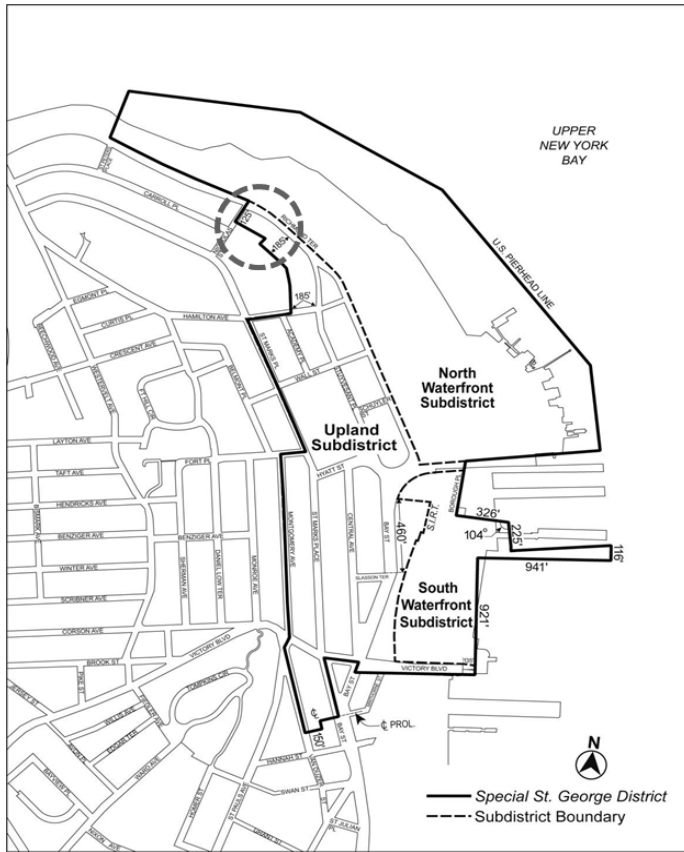

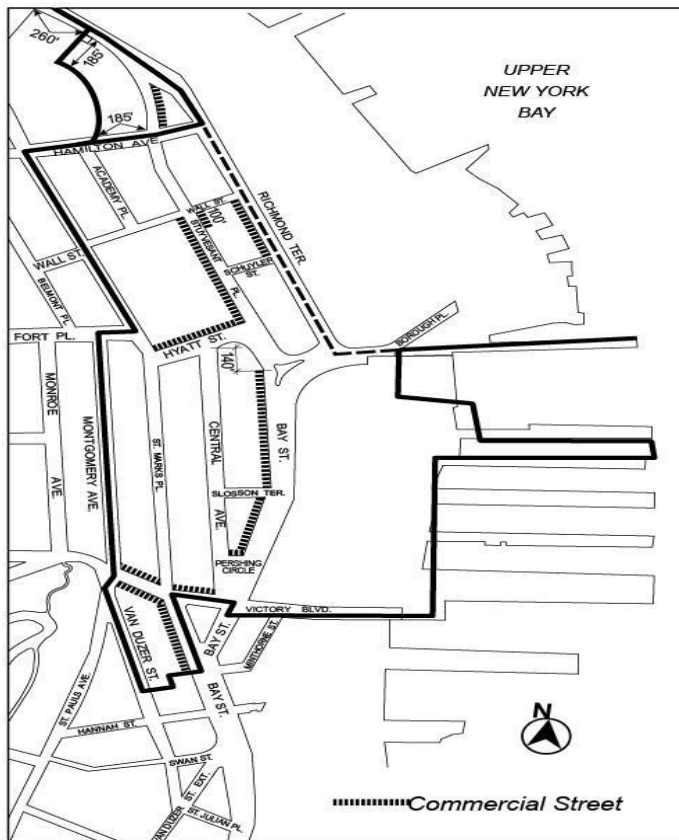

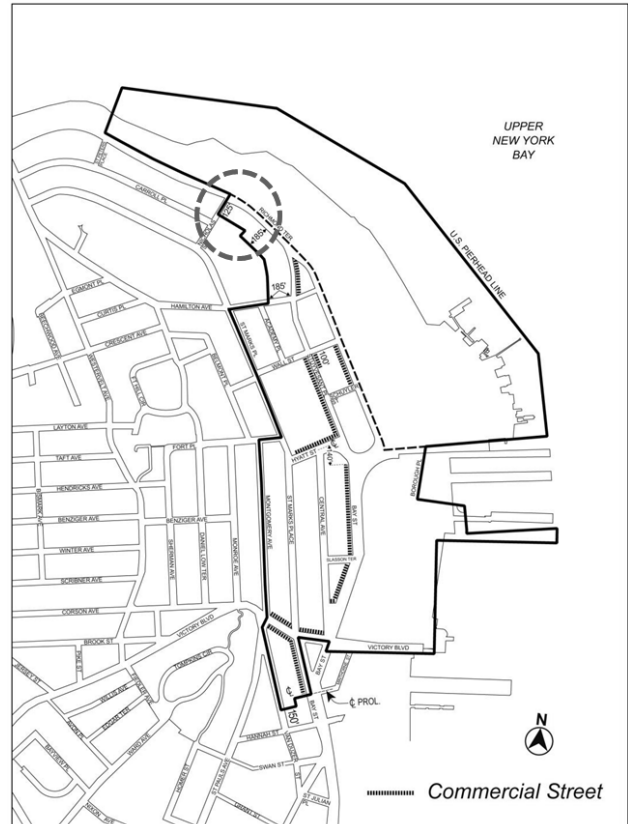


Map 2 – Commercial Streets [date of adoption]

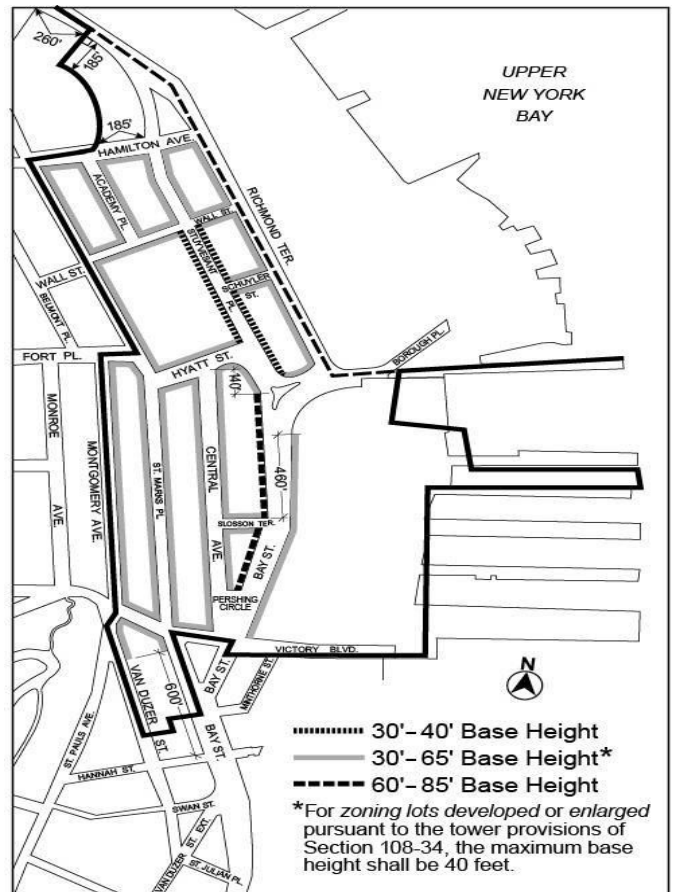

Map 3 – Minimum and Maximum Base Heights [date of adoption]

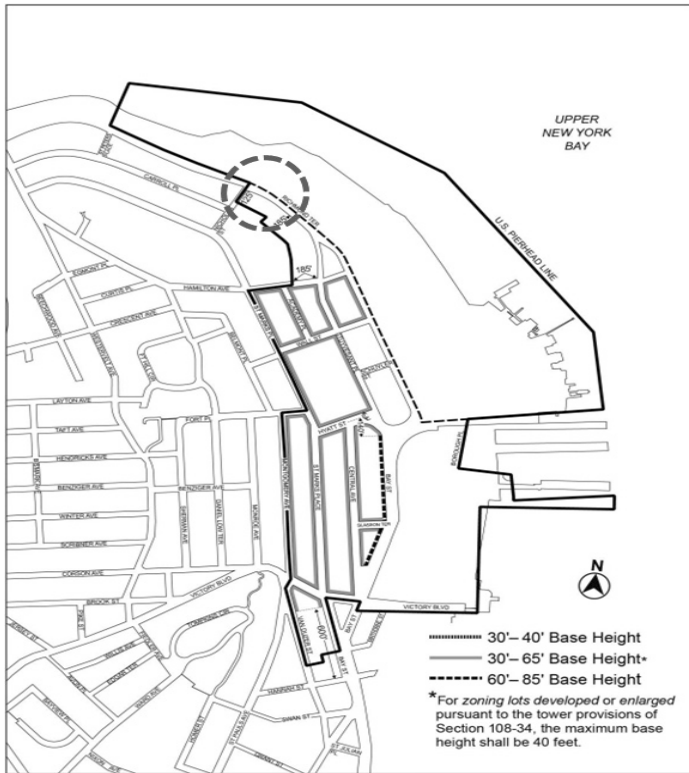

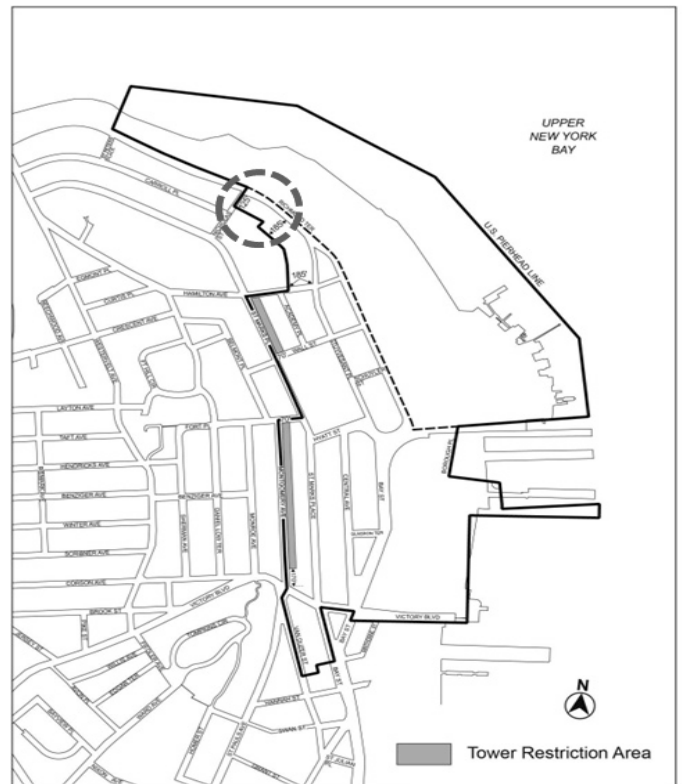

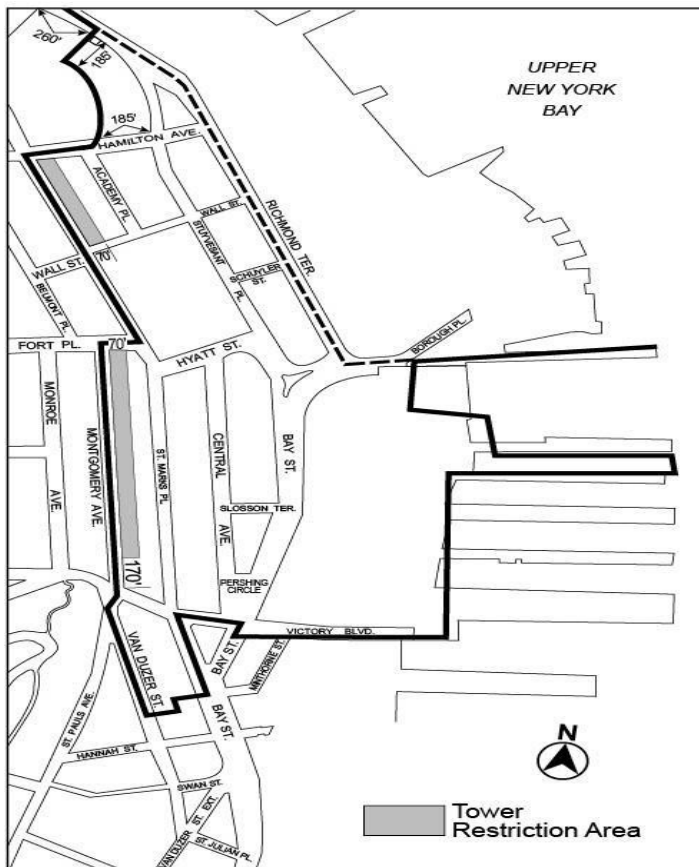
Map 4 – Tower Restriction Area [date of adoption]

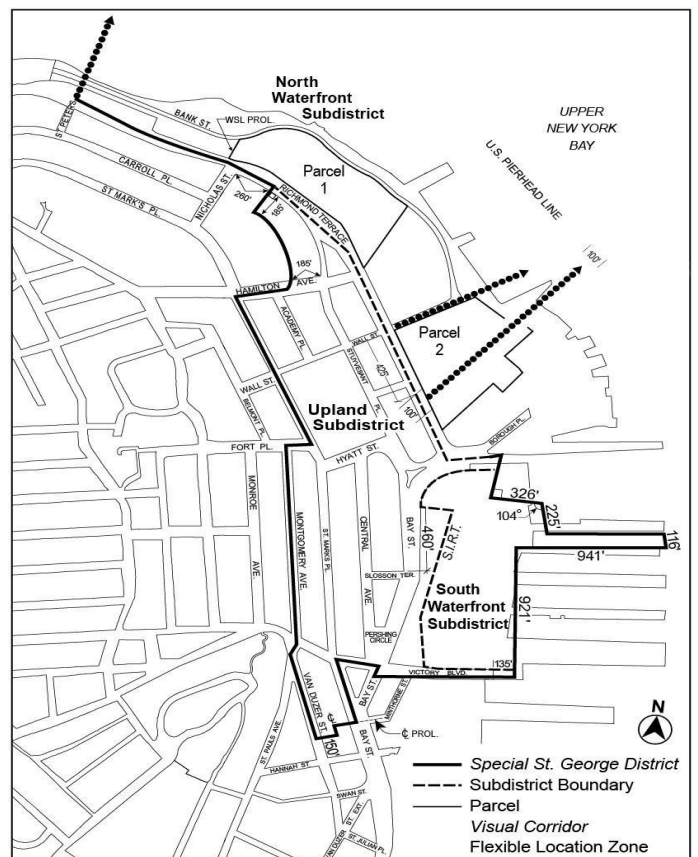


Map 5 – Visual Corridors and Parcels [date of adoption]

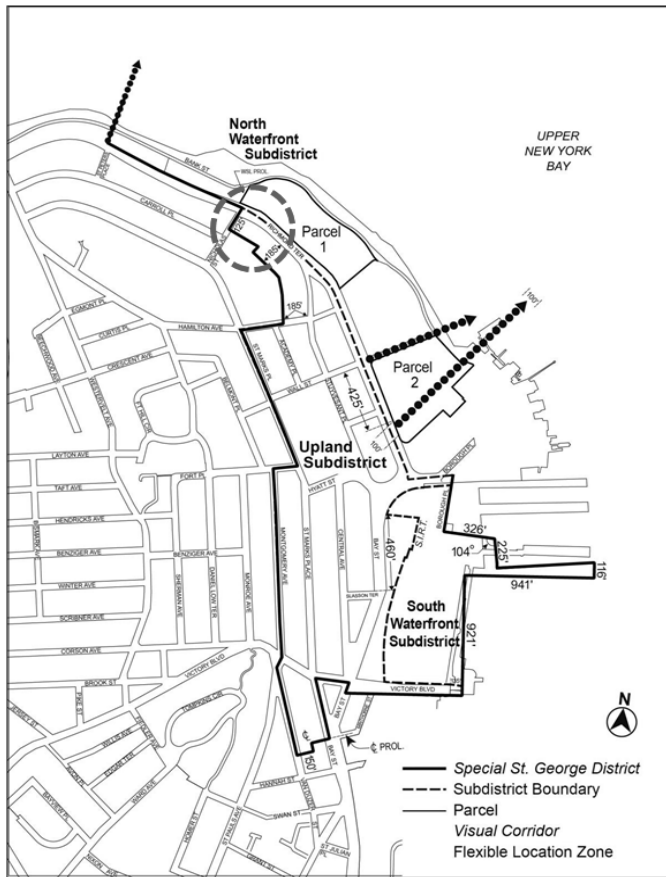

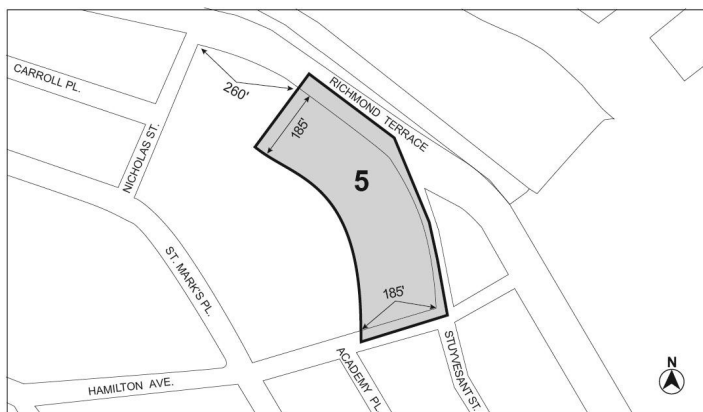
