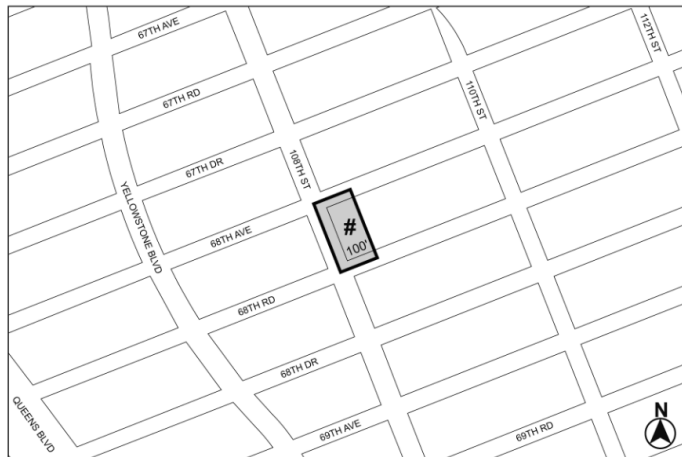

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Department of Citywide Administrative Services proposes to amend Board of Estimate Calendar No. 142 dated December 21, 1989 via mayoral authorization.

In accordance with Section 384 of the New York City Charter, a Real Property A&D Public Hearing will be held regarding the proposed amendment on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, commencing at 10:00 A.M. via Call-In Number 1-646-992-2010, Access Code: 717 876 299.

The proposed amendment will remove the “transitional housing for the formerly homeless elderly” requirement included as a business term in a lease offered at public auction, and executed on January 9, 1991 for Manhattan Block 387, Lots 49 and 53. This action is to support the sale and redevelopment of Manhattan Block 387, Lot 49, located at 269 East 4th Street, to the current tenant, consistent with the terms outlined in the purchase option in the referenced lease. This requirement was imposed as part of the prior authorization for the lease of former Lot 53, which has since been merged into abutting Lot 49.

The proposed sale and redevelopment will allow for the continued use of the property as a homeless shelter while providing for the new development of affordable housing units, with a “not-for-profit community facility uses only” requirement, pursuant to Calendar No. 1 dated June 11, 1981 and Calendar No. 62 dated November 19, 1987.

If approved by the Mayor of the City of New York, the Department of Citywide Administrative Services shall be authorized to sell the property without the “transitional housing for the formerly homeless elderly” restriction, in accordance with the purchase option in the lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York, including but not limited to the New York Executive Law, the New York City Charter and the Administrative Code of the City of New York, and the common law authority to protect the public in the event of an emergency, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Section 1 of Emergency Executive Order No. 1.38, dated July 14, 2026, is hereby extended for five (5) days.

§ 2. DOC, in consultation with the Law Department, shall regularly update the Mayor regarding additional suspensions that can be lapsed to comply with the implementation action plan developed pursuant to Section 2 of Emergency Executive Order 1, dated January 5, 2026, and with applicable laws and regulations that presently do not apply pursuant to Emergency Executive Orders.

§ 3. This Emergency Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.

EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 2.39

July 19, 2026

WHEREAS, pursuant to a state of emergency first declared by Emergency Executive Order No. 224, dated October 7, 2022, and subsequent orders extending such state of emergency, the City has operated Humanitarian Emergency Response and Relief Centers to provide temporary housing in response to the substantial increase in new arrivals during recent years; and

WHEREAS, such orders issued prior to January 5, 2026 did not provide or require a plan for actions that would be taken to eliminate the need for the suspensions and modifications of laws and rules effected by the orders; and

WHEREAS, such state of emergency continues for the present pending the expedited development and implementation of such plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, by the laws of the State of New York and the City of New York, including but not limited to the New York Executive Law, the New York City Charter and the Administrative Code of the City of New York, and the common law authority to protect the public in the event of an emergency:

Section 1. Section 1 of Emergency Executive Order No. 2.38, dated July 14, 2026, is hereby extended for five (5) days.

§ 2. The Department of Social Services and the Department of Homeless Services, in consultation with the Law Department, shall regularly update the Mayor on the implementation action plan and efforts to phase out the continued use of facilities that have been operated in reliance on the suspensions and modifications of laws and rules.

§ 3. This Emergency Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless it is terminated or modified at an earlier date.

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 18

July 20, 2026

OPEN FOR SMALL BUSINESS

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a new era for small businesses, the backbone of New York City's economy and its neighborhoods, and is launching Overhauling Procedures and Expanding Navigation ("OPEN") to continue to make it easier for small businesses to interact with government; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order 11 of 2026, the City has identified a set of reforms reducing regulatory burdens on small businesses and established a foundation upon which further reforms can be built; and

WHEREAS, the City's small businesses continue to share the challenges and delays they face in navigating permitting and licensing processes across City agencies and other entities which are required to open a storefront business in particular; and

WHEREAS, the City's small businesses also continue to articulate their desire for a city government that treats them with consistency, respect, and fairness; and

WHEREAS, the City's Business Owner Bill of Rights and Customer Service Survey, established in accordance with section 15 of the Charter, were intended to provide such excellence in customer service, but many business owners are unaware of their rights or available remedies; and

WHEREAS, consistent interagency coordination is needed to drive continuous improvement in how the City interfaces with and regulates small businesses; and

WHEREAS, the affordability crisis affecting small businesses means that they can do everything right in their interactions with City government but still struggle to stay open because of other factors such as rising commercial rent, insurance, utility bills, and abuses of market power by some larger, corporate actors;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Expanding the Mission of the NYC Business Express Service Team. The Department of Small Business Services ("SBS") shall implement an expanded vision for the NYC Business Express Service Team ("NYC BEST") to enhance offerings to business owners, with an emphasis on assisting those seeking to open a storefront business. SBS shall:

- a. Assist businesses to open faster by establishing a new concierge service for licensing and permitting. SBS shall assign each NYC BEST client a dedicated project manager to assist the business owner in opening their business, helping the business owner identify required licenses and permits; providing appropriate assistance with applying for such licenses and permits; providing guidance on common pitfalls that can delay application processing; coordinating required pre-opening qualifying inspections on behalf of the business owner with the relevant agencies as appropriate; and providing updates to the business owner regarding the status of their license and/or permit applications.
- b. Assist businesses to open faster, stay open, and avoid fines with "just in time" compliance education. SBS shall partner with relevant regulatory agencies as identified by the Commissioner of Small Business Services to offer tailored, timely onsite compliance education to storefront business owners prior to a pre-opening qualifying inspection or a periodic inspection after the business is open. SBS shall deliver such compliance education no more than 60 days, or as soon as practicable, before an upcoming pre-opening qualifying inspection or periodic inspection. Such compliance education shall not be made available to business owners in advance of a follow-up inspection or an inspection conducted in response to a complaint.
- c. Assist businesses to resolve summonses through pre-adjudication assistance. SBS shall provide business owners with guidance regarding options available to resolve summonses and violations issued by City agencies. Such guidance shall include, but not be limited to, whether a violation is curable and steps to take to cure such violation, options to settle the summons or otherwise resolve it prior to an administrative hearing and how to engage in such settlement or resolution process, information on actions the business owners can take to come into compliance with City laws and rules, and information on actions the business owner can take to respond to the summons or violation before an administrative tribunal.

§ 2. Business Owner Bill of Rights for a New Era.

- a. Beginning September 1, 2026, consistent with section 15(f) of the Charter, SBS shall conduct outreach and education on the Business Owner Bill of Rights, updated as of the date of this Order (the "Updated Business Owner Bill of Rights").¹
- b. Beginning September 1, 2026, SBS shall conduct outreach and education on an updated Customer Service Survey. Prior to such outreach and education, the Mayor's Office of Operations and SBS shall review and recommend any revisions to the Customer Service Survey by no later than August 31, 2026, to make the survey a more effective tool for interagency partners to measure customer service performance.
- c. Beginning October 1, 2026, inspectors for the Department of Buildings ("DOB"), the Department of Consumer and Worker Protection ("DCWP"), the Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP"), the Fire Department ("FDNY"), the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene ("DOHMH"), the Department of Parks and Recreation ("DPR"), the Department of Sanitation ("DSNY"), and the Department of Transportation ("DOT") shall, consistent with section 15(f) of the Charter,

distribute a physical copy of the Updated Business Owner Bill of Rights to business owners, managers, or relevant employees at the beginning of every onsite inspection of a storefront business as well as information on how to access (i) the Customer Service Survey electronically and, if physical copies of the Updated Business Owner Bill of Rights are unavailable, in all designated citywide languages, (ii) digital translations of the Updated Business Owner Bill of Rights in all designated citywide languages, consistent with all applicable local laws. Such distribution shall be supplemental to any distribution required by section 15 of the Charter or any other local law that requires distribution of the Business Owner Bill of Rights.

d. Beginning October 1, 2026, Mayoral agencies shall conspicuously post the Updated Business Owner Bill of Rights at every public office, service center, and point of service where business owners may receive, request, or apply for city services, permits, licenses, or approvals.

§3. NYC Small Business Working Group. SBS shall establish a small business working group to facilitate interagency coordination, problem solving, and solutions development to deliver a government that works better for its small businesses.

a. SBS and the Deputy Mayor for Economic Justice shall regularly convene representatives from the offices of the Deputy Mayor for Operations, the Deputy Mayor for Health and Human Services, the Deputy Mayor for Housing and Planning, the Chief Counsel to the Mayor and City Hall, the Mayor's Office of Operations, DOB, DCWP, DEP, FDNY, DOHMH, the Law Department, DPR, DSNY, and DOT to advance improvements to the processes City agencies implement to license and regulate small businesses. The working group shall consult with the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings on matters regarding adjudicatory processes and the Office of Management and Budget on budgetary implications of potential solutions or reforms.

b. The working group shall meet at least quarterly to discuss and develop plans to improve government services for small businesses, including, but not limited to, addressing:

- i. Necessary process improvements to eliminate pain points experienced during the licensing or permitting process in an effort to decrease processing times for each license or permit required to open a business;
- ii. Quality control and training provided to City staff to eliminate inconsistent enforcement guidance and improve compliance education provided to businesses;
- iii. Policy or operational interventions to increase compliance rates for the most frequently issued violations and decrease administrative hearing default rates and summons dismissal rates;
- iv. Trends in Customer Service Survey results;
- v. Effectiveness and complementarity of City agency business education and outreach efforts; and
- vi. Implementation of capital projects and technological improvements needed to improve service delivery to business owners.

c. The working group shall meet at least annually with the Deputy Mayor for Economic Justice to review and present recommendations on proposed regulatory reforms.

§ 4. Embedding a Culture of Continuous Improvement in Customer Service Delivery in the Practices of Regulatory Agencies.

- a. DOB, DCWP, DEP, FDNY, DOHMH, DPR, DSNY, and DOT shall:
 - i. No later than October 31, 2026, and annually thereafter, submit any planned customer service training courses that will be used in the following calendar year to the Mayor's Office of Operations for review. Such agencies shall ensure that all inspectors complete such training courses by the end of the applicable calendar year. All customer service training courses submitted shall comply with the standardized customer service training curriculum developed by the Mayor's Office of Operations pursuant to section 15 of the Charter.
 - ii. No later than February 1, 2027, and annually thereafter, submit to the Mayor's Office of Operations the number of inspectors who completed customer service training courses during the previous calendar year and the percentage of the agency's inspectorial workforce that such number represents.

- iii. Consistent with the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the City of New York and applicable collective bargaining agreements, consider feedback from the Mayor's Office of Operations' Customer Service Survey for inclusion as a performance standard in such agency's performance evaluation program.

b. No later than December 1, 2026, and annually thereafter, the Mayor's Office of Operations and SBS shall recognize at least one inspector from DOB, DCWP, DEP, FDNY, DOHMH, DPR, DSNY, and DOT for excellence in public service. Nominees shall be drawn from such agencies with consideration of positive feedback in the Customer Service Survey, relevant feedback collected through NYC BEST, and input from each respective agency's leadership.

§ 5. Identifying Additional City Interventions to Tackle the Small Business Affordability Crisis.

a. By October 31, 2026, SBS shall present recommendations to the Deputy Mayor for Economic Justice regarding initiatives or policies to address other costs that small businesses face outside of those that are a function of their regulatory experience with government, including but not limited to liability insurance, commercial rents, and utilities.

b. By October 31, 2026, SBS shall provide recommendations to the Deputy Mayor for Economic Justice regarding initiatives or policies to drive down storefront vacancy rates in commercial corridors with high vacancy rates, or chronic storefront vacancy in certain areas.

§ 6. Effective Date. This Order shall take effect immediately.

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 19

July 23, 2026

INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE AND PEDESTRIAN ALERTS FOR THE CITY FLEET

WHEREAS, nationwide in 2024, there were 39,254 traffic fatalities reported, with speeding a contributing factor in 29% of fatalities, and 1,319 fatalities involving trucks at intersection; and

WHEREAS, in New York City, there were 110 pedestrian fatalities and 211 total fatalities from traffic collisions in fiscal year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City operates a large fleet ("NYC Fleet") of vehicles, trucks, and motorized equipment that is critical to the daily provision of municipal services; and

WHEREAS, Intelligent Speed Assistance ("ISA") is a commercially available product that can detect the local road speed and physically prevent a vehicle from exceeding that limit; and

WHEREAS, DCAS has successfully implemented the largest ISA equipped fleet in the country, with 1,000 vehicles at 22 agencies across 23 vehicle types that have already logged millions of miles using ISA since August 2022; and

WHEREAS, NYC Fleet's ISA program has demonstrated a 64% reduction in dangerous speeding among equipped vehicles and in October 2025, DCAS announced an initiative to expand ISA to all civilian fleet vehicles as part of the SFTP; and

WHEREAS, turn alerts on trucks are established technologies that can warn pedestrians and bicyclists of truck turns as they occur, mitigating the increased risk posed by the size and design of trucks, particularly when making turns; and

WHEREAS, in January 2025, the Department of Citywide Administrative Services ("DCAS") designated pedestrian alerts as a best practice technology in the City's Safe Fleet Transition Plan ("SFTP") and has rolled out this technology on 800 trucks, with the goal of expanding the use fleetwide;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as the Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Definitions. For the purposes of this Order, the following terms have the following meanings:

- a. "Bureau of Quality Assurance ("BQA")" means the unit at DCAS that performs technical inspections of equipment and vehicles to ensure compliance with contract specifications.
- b. "Chief Fleet Officer" means the DCAS official appointed by the Commissioner, in accordance with Executive Order

161 of 2012, who is responsible for implementing policies and procedures to ensure safe, reliable, and proper use of City vehicles, or their duly authorized designee.

c. "City fleet truck" means a motor vehicle owned or leased by a City agency with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating exceeding 10,000 pounds. For purposes of this Order, this term shall not include off-road construction vehicles or emergency service trucks as determined by DCAS.

d. "City civilian fleet vehicle" means a motor vehicle owned or leased by a city agency other than any of the following vehicles:

- i. Vehicles utilized primarily in an off-road capacity;
 - ii. Waste removal, plow, and salt trucks operated by the Department of Sanitation ("DSNY");
 - iii. Vehicles whose function or assignment is to serve in an emergency response capacity or which are authorized to utilize lights and sirens;
 - iv. Vehicles that cannot be equipped with ISA as a matter of technical limitations, as determined by DCAS;
 - v. Vehicles with a unique role or design that would warrant an exemption, to be determined by DCAS; and
 - vi. Vehicles used primarily in areas with documented cellular disruption, as determined by DCAS.
- e. "Intelligent Speed Assistance ("ISA")" means technology that meets the following specifications:
- i. Automatically prevents a vehicle from further acceleration once such vehicle has reached the speed limit in any location, or a pre-determined threshold above such limit, without implementing braking, except that the driver shall be provided with the ability to temporarily override the ISA in the event of an emergency or if certain traffic navigation needs warrant such override; and
 - ii. Utilizes GPS positioning and digital speed limit maps to determine the speed to be enforced.
- f. "Pedestrian Alerts" means a device affixed to the exterior of two sides of a truck that is wired to the turn signals of such truck and emits an audible alert during truck turns sufficient to warn pedestrians, bicyclists, and others of the truck's turning motion.

§ 2. Intelligent Speed Assistance (ISA) for all Civilian Fleet Vehicles: Any contract for the purchase or lease of a City civilian fleet vehicle shall require that such vehicle be equipped with ISA. ISA must be installed prior to a City civilian vehicle being accepted by the Bureau of Quality Assurance ("BQA"). To the extent that funding is available, DCAS will use best efforts to retrofit with ISA City civilian fleet vehicles acquired or leased before the effective date of this Order.

§ 3. ISA functionality: DCAS shall manage the functionality and operations of ISA equipped on City vehicles and shall:

- a. Manage the maximum speed limits of ISA equipped City vehicles;
- b. Monitor the implementation of the ISA system and its use in ISA equipped City vehicles, including by measuring incidents of vehicle speeding, vehicle collisions, and use of system overrides;
- c. Determine restrictions below the posted speed limits for sensitive pedestrian locations such as parks areas or school zones as appropriate; and
- d. Implement system adjustments and exemptions as necessary.

§ 4. Pedestrian alerts for all City fleet trucks:

- a. Any contract for the purchase or lease of a City fleet truck shall require that such vehicle be equipped with a pedestrian alert. Such pedestrian alert shall be installed prior to a City fleet truck being accepted by the BQA.
- b. By June 30, 2029, DCAS shall retrofit all existing City Fleet Trucks with Pedestrian Alerts.
- c. DCAS, in coordination with emergency service agencies, shall test pedestrian alerts on emergency service trucks to determine the effectiveness of the pedestrian alerts on these trucks. Where such pedestrian alert is found to be effective on an emergency service truck, DCAS shall take all steps practicable to ensure that future purchases of such emergency service trucks include pedestrian alerts.

§ 5. Exemptions:

a. DCAS shall issue, and update as appropriate, guidance identifying vehicles that cannot be equipped with ISA based upon their role or design and areas with documented cellular disruption or otherwise setting forth a procedure for agencies to obtain exemptions identified in this Order.

b. An agency may submit a request for an exemption from section 2 or section 4 of this Order to DCAS, which shall grant such request where implementation would be impracticable. In determining whether implementation is impracticable, DCAS may consider whether implementation will disrupt contract implementation; is infeasible for technical, operating or design reasons; or will impose undue costs.

§ 6. Agency Cooperation: All mayoral agency heads are directed to cooperate fully with DCAS and the Chief Fleet Officer in implementing and complying with this order.

§ 7. Rules of Construction. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to supersede any applicable collective bargaining obligation.

§ 8. Effective Date. This order shall take effect immediately.
