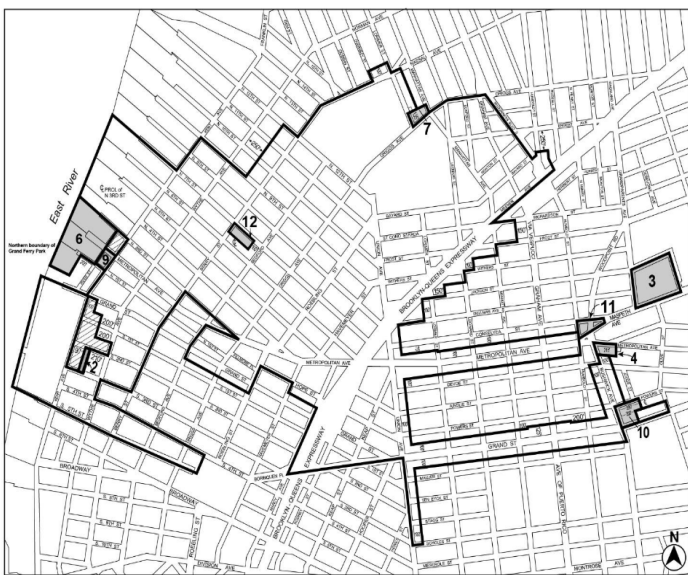

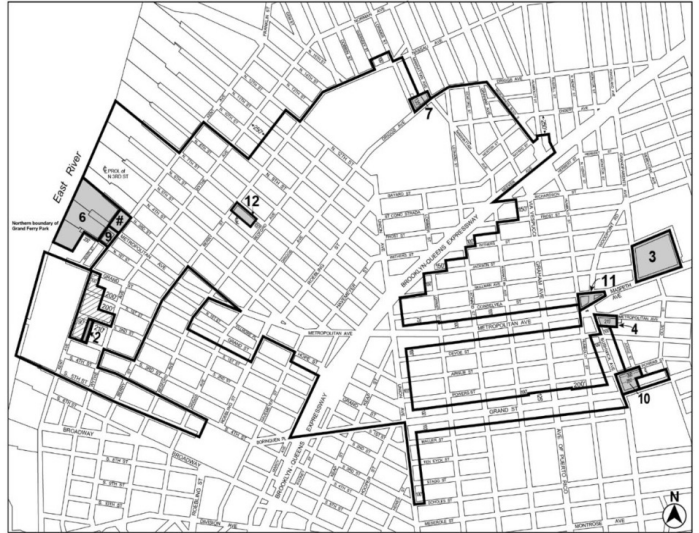

**Revision of New York City Department of Parks & Recreation’s Rules**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN** the Commissioner of the Department of Parks &

Recreation (“the Department”) by Sections 389 and 533(a)(9) of the New York City Charter and in accordance with the requirements of Section 1043 of the New York City Charter, the Department hereby revises section 2-14 of Chapter 2 of Title 56 of the Official Compilation of the Rules of the City of New York.

The Department provided the public with the opportunity to submit written comments regarding the rules in accordance with the notice published in the City Record or electronically through NYC RULES at [www.nyc.gov/nycrules](http://www.nyc.gov/nycrules) and a public hearing was held on February 18, 2026 at Chelsea Recreation Center, 430 West 25th Street, New York, NY 10001. The Department did not receive any comments.

**Statement of Basis and Purpose**

The Department is revising section 2-14 of Chapter 2 of Title 56 of the Rules of the City of New York, pursuant to which people with disabilities are eligible for significant discounts on recreation center membership fees. For example, a person with proof of disability may have their annual membership fee at a recreation center with an indoor pool discounted from \$150 to \$25. The rule change adds categories of documents that the Department will now accept as proof that a person with a disability is eligible for the reduced recreation center membership fee.

Currently, a person with a disability is eligible for a reduced Recreation Center Membership fee if, when purchasing or renewing their membership, the individual presents one or more documents from a list of approved documents to support the individual’s disability status. Following consultation with the Mayor’s Office for People with Disabilities (“MOPD”), the Department is adding four categories of documents to the approved list to make it easier for individuals who may not have one of the documents on the current list to receive the membership discount. These documents are all currently accepted by NYC Ferry as proof of disability for their discount program.

The Department’s authority for these rules is found in Section 389, 533(a)(9), and 1043 of the New York City Charter.

New material is underlined.

[Deleted material is in brackets.]

“Shall” and “must” denote mandatory requirements and may be used interchangeably in the rules of this Department, unless otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

**Section 1. The definition of Person with Disability Membership Fee in subdivision (a) of section 2-14 of chapter 2 of Title 56 of the Rules of the City of New York is amended to read as follows:**

**Person with Disability Membership Fee.** “Person with Disability Membership Fee” means the membership fee for use of recreation centers for all patrons who present government-issued photo identification along with one of the following documents when purchasing or renewing a membership:

- New York City Department of Transportation Parking Permit for People with Disabilities (PPPD);
- MTA Access-A-Ride ID card;
- MTA Reduced Fare ID card;
- Certification from the New York State Office of Mental Health that the patron is receiving services from a program it licenses, operates, certifies, or funds;
- Certification from the New York State Office for People with Developmental Disabilities that the patron is eligible to receive services from a program it licenses, operates, certifies, or funds;
- Certification from the New York State Commission for the Blind that the patron has a central visual acuity of 20/200 or less or limitation in the field of vision such that the widest diameter of the visual field subtends an angle no greater than 20 degrees in the better eye with the use of a correcting lens; [or]
- New York State Commission for the Blind registration letter;
- New York State Parks Individual Access Pass[.];
- Disability award letter from the United States Social Security Administration, the United States Railroad Retirement Board, or the United States Postal Service;
- Letter from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs stating that the patron is entitled to veterans disability benefits; or
- Medicare Card (if patron is less than 62 years of age).

The membership does not include session fees. Membership includes, but is not limited to, use of fitness equipment, indoor pools and computer resource centers. Documents presented to the Department will not be retained after the applicant’s eligibility for the membership fee is determined.

This notice shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Queens Botanical Garden (QBG).

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about June 17, 2026 the City of New York (the City) will submit, on behalf of the QBG, a request to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Project Funding (CPF) funds authorized under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024 (Public Law 118-42) to undertake an activity known as the Queens Botanical Garden Pavilion project. Through this project, the QBG proposes to use approximately \$500,000 in federally-appropriated CPF funds, administered by HUD, as part of the overall project costing approximately \$1,950,000, to construct an approximately 3,200 square foot open air pavilion within the southwest corner of the garden.

Project activities would include the following:

- Site Demolition: which would likely include Shrub removal, clearing of debris, and topsoil stripping.
Excavation and grading: Grading (shaping and leveling the ground surface) to design specifications, creating utility trenches and establishing drainage slopes.
Pile installation: Installation of piles for the foundation.
Foundation construction: Concrete cast in place foundation
Stage construction: The stage would be a concrete cast in place slab (additional ground disturbance not anticipated but possible). There will also be prefabricated columns that will be installed to complete the structure.
Utility installation: Installation of water lines for irrigation, and power lines for the stage.
Landscaping: Final grading, likely an installation of erosion control measures such as a jute mesh, rain garden planting,

installation of tall grasses, shrubs, and the installation of a new Katsura tree.

- Site furnishing: Installation of bench bump outs for benches will involve minor ground disturbance.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The New York City Mayor's Office of Management and Budget (NYC OMB) is the Responsible Entity for this project and has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

NYC OMB certifies to HUD that the City and Julie Freeman, in her capacity as Certifying Officer, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the NYBG to use CPF Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and NYC OMB's certification for a period of fifteen (15) days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of NYC OMB; (b) NYC OMB has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to CPDRROFNYC@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
