The team also supports program and policy development for a variety of agency and City Hall initiatives. Throughout its work, R&C maintains a focus on implementation, ensuring that emerging technology solutions can be considered in terms of their eventual role in agency operations. The team hosts subject matter experts in Smart Cities & IOT, and AI/ML.
