DCAS and NYPD Partner With London To Promote Sustainable Fleet

On April 12 and 13, the New York Police Department (NYPD) and DCAS will join the City of London at the Fleet Vision International Show to promote sustainable, safe, and efficient fleet management. Since 2017, London and NYC Fleet have been working together on fleet initiatives including side-guards, high vision trucks, other safe vehicle designs, and fleet electrification. Our annual events had previously been promoted as the Future Fleets Forums and are now the Fleet Vision International Show.

Governmental participants and speakers at the event include Barry Sheerman, member of Parliament (MP) for Huddersfield and one of England's longest-standing MPs, having served since 1979.

Other speakers and participants include:

- Elected member of the City of London Corporation and Chair of the Port Health and Environmental Committee Keith Bottomley.
- Strategy Planner Freight of Transport for London John Oosthuizen.

These government representatives will be joined by representatives of fleet, truck, and alternative fuel manufacturers; environmental advocates; and fleet industry leaders.

Government and commercial fleet is an international industry. Moving the industry to electric and safer fleet vehicles and trucks requires large fleet customers pushing on all fronts, and this partnership with London furthers that effort. NYC certainly leads in many areas of fleet management including telematics, biofuels, policing, and emergency response operations. London has provided important leadership to us, especially in our Vision Zero Initiative, truck side-guards, intelligent speed assist (ISA), high vision trucks, and safety reporting. Together, we are both

pushing to transition to a fully electric fleet as fast as we can.

“The Westminster Commission for Road Air Quality is proud to be partnered with two world-leading cities – London and New York – to help deliver Fleet Vision International – The Show. This event addresses the significant issue of transport emissions and provides sustainable solutions that organizations can implement right now. The City of London and the City of New York have taken the forefront on the road to net-zero by eliminating diesel from their fleets and replacing these units with electric vehicles. Their aggressive sustainability programs are an example to other cities. We, as the Westminster Commission for Road Air Quality, stand by them in their quest for cleaner air through our unique transatlantic partnership. I certainly believe that each one of us possesses the right to breathe clean air and have made it my mission to push for more significant action in UK Parliament,” commented Barry Sheerman, MP for Huddersfield, and chairman of the Westminster Commission for Road Air Quality.
