Why This Matters

Every DCAS-owned building has a designated **Fire & Life Safety Team** trained to guide occupants during drills and emergencies.

Knowing who they are helps ensure a safer and more organized response.

Where to Find the Fire and Life Safety Team Chart

The FDNY requires that each floor display a **Fire & Life Safety Team chart**. Charts are typically located:

- Near elevator banks, or
- By fire exit stairwells

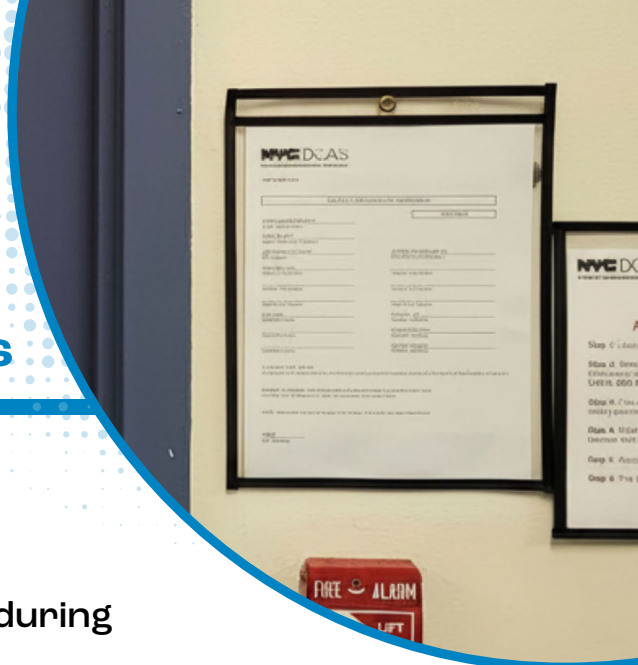
The chart lists names, roles, and contact information for your floor's Fire and Life Safety Team.

Why It's Important

Your Fire & Life Safety Team:

- Are trained in what to do during an alarm activation
- Provide instructions during alarms and drills
- Assist with evacuation
- Conduct accountability procedures
- Coordinate with the Fire and Life Safety Director

Take a moment to locate the chart and become familiar with your team. Each role has specific responsibilities during an emergency.
