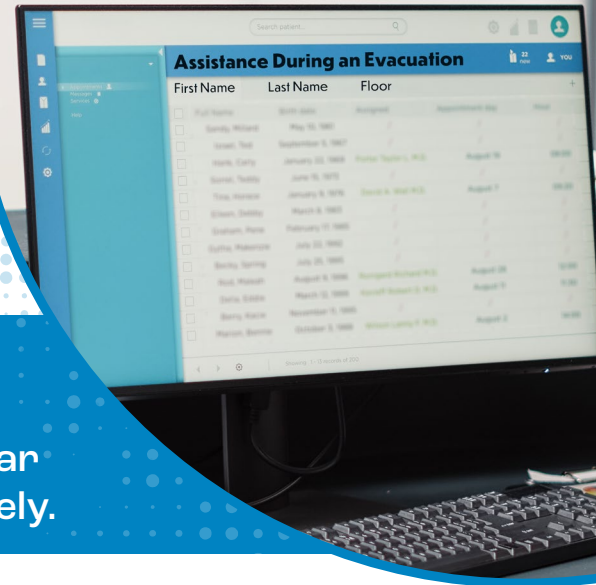


Would You Need Assistance During an Emergency?

Your Safety Matters

Every DCAS-owned building has a trained Fire & Life Safety Team dedicated to guiding occupants during emergencies. Their role is to plan ahead, provide clear direction, and ensure everyone is accounted for safely.



Need Assistance During an Evacuation?

If you believe you need help or cannot use stairwells during an emergency, it is important to request placement on the list for assistance during an emergency. This allows the Fire & Life Safety Team to prepare in advance and respond effectively.

Why You Must Request to Be Added

Out of respect for privacy and confidentiality:

- No one is automatically placed on the list.
- Personal or medical needs are not assumed.
- Placement on the list occurs only when requested.

If the team is not informed ahead of time, assistance cannot be properly arranged.

Who Should Consider Being Added?

Anyone who may have difficulty evacuating safely, including:

- Mobility limitations
- Temporary injuries
- Pregnancy
- Medical conditions, and more

Temporary situations are just as important as permanent ones.

How to Be Added

To request placement on the list:

- Contact your floor warden or fire & life safety director.
- Provide your name and floor location.
- Notify the team if your situation changes.

Advance preparation allows the Fire & Life Safety Team to better support you when it matters most.
