WHEN TO APPLY: From: August 3, 2005 APPLICATION FEE: \$50.00

THE TEST DATE: The practical test is expected to begin on Tuesday, October 11, 2005.

WHAT THE JOB INVOLVES: Structure Maintainers - Group E perform plumbing work in subway, surface, and elevated structures, including stations, enclosures, tunnels, and related buildings; install, maintain and repair plumbing fixtures in toilets, sink rooms and heating systems; clean, test, dismantle, install and repair pipes, fixtures, vents and hot water heaters; keep records; load, unload and drive vans and trucks; perform other structural work when necessary, including incidental painting; may serve as a flagger and respond to signals on tracks; and perform related work.

Some of the physical activities performed by Structure Maintainers - Group E and environmental conditions experienced are: crouching while working in confined spaces; climbing and descending ladders and stairs; working on elevated structures; distinguishing colors of lights; making visual and tactile inspections; responding to sounds and warning bells; using hand tools; carrying tools and equipment weighing up to 50 lbs.; and working in various field locations, including on and around subway tracks and structures, and in the proximity of electrified rails and moving trains; and working outdoors in inclement weather.

(This is a brief description of what you might do in this position and does not include all the duties of this position.)

THE SALARY: The current minimum salary is \$23.8050 per hour. This rate is subject to change.

HOW TO APPLY: If you believe you are eligible to take this examination, refer to the "Required Form" section below for the form that you must fill out. Return the completed form and the application fee to DCAS Applications Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, New York, NY 10007 **by mail only**. DCAS will not accept applications in person from candidates.

ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE EXAMINATION: This examination is open to each employee of the New York City Transit Authority who **on the date of the practical test**:

- (1) is employed in the non-competitive title of Transit Structural Apprentice Group E, and has satisfactorily completed the 3-year Transit Structural Apprentice Group E program in plumbing; and
- (2) is not otherwise ineligible.

If you do not know if you are eligible, check with your department's Human Resources representative.

You may be given the test before a review of your eligibility. You are responsible for determining whether or not you meet the eligibility requirements for this examination prior to submitting your application. If you are marked "Not Eligible," your application fee will not be refunded and you will not receive a score.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE PROMOTED: At the time of promotion, you must be employed in the title of Transit Structural Apprentice - Group E.

REQUIRED FORM:

Application for Examination: Make sure that you follow all instructions included with your application form, including payment of fee. Save a copy of the instructions for future reference.

REQUIREMENTS TO BE PROMOTED:

Driver License Requirement: By the time you are promoted to this position, you must have a motor vehicle driver license valid in the State of New York. If you have serious moving violations, license suspension(s) or an accident record, you may be disqualified. In addition, once you are promoted, you will be required to obtain a Class B Commercial Driver License with no restrictions, valid in the State of New York, within six (6) months of your date of promotion. Both the motor vehicle driver license and the Class B Commercial Driver License with no restrictions must be maintained for the duration of your employment.

Medical Requirement: Medical guidelines have been established for the position of Structure Maintainer - Group E. Candidates will be examined to determine whether they can perform the essential functions of the position of Structure Maintainer - Group E. Where appropriate, a reasonable accommodation will be provided for a person with a disability to enable him or her to take the examination, and/or to perform the essential functions of the job.

Drug Screening Requirement: You must pass a drug screening in order to be promoted.

- **ADMISSION CARD**: You should receive an Admission Card in the mail about 10 days before the date of the test. If you do not receive an Admission Card at least 4 days before the test date, you must go to the Examining Service Section, 1 Centre Street, 14th floor, Manhattan, to obtain a duplicate card.
- **THE TEST**: You will be given a practical test. You must achieve a score of at least 70% to pass this test. Your score on this test will determine your place on an eligible list.

The practical test will measure your ability to produce two satisfactory samples of plumbing work: one of galvanized steel and one of copper tubing.

THE TEST RESULTS: If you pass the practical test and are marked eligible, your name will be placed in final score order on an eligible list and you will be given a list number. You will be notified by mail of your test results. If you meet all requirements and conditions, you will be considered for promotion when your name is reached on the eligible list.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

Late Filing: Consult your department's Human Resources representative to determine the procedure for filing a late application if you meet one or more of the following conditions:

- (1) You are absent from work for at least one-half of the application period and cannot apply for reasons such as vacation, sick leave or military duty; or
- You become eligible after the above application period but on or before the date of the practical test.

Special Test Accommodations: If you plan to request special testing accommodations due to disability or an alternate test date due to your religious belief, follow the instructions included with the "Application for Examination."

The General Examination Regulations of the Department of Citywide Administrative Services apply to this examination and are part of this Notice of Examination. They are posted and copies are available in the Applications Center of the Division of Citywide Personnel Services, 18 Washington Street, NY, NY.
