SHIP CARPENTER (NY HELPS PROGRAM)

General Statement of Duties and Responsibilities

Under supervision, perform ship carpentry work; performs related work.

Examples of Typical Tasks

Uses and operates all carpentry shop hand powered machinery, tools and equipment; repairs and erects partitions, doors and windows; works from prints and measurements.

Does all necessary woodworking repairs and maintenance of ferries, floating equipment, terminals and related buildings; replaces broken glass, constructs and installs scaffolding; constructs and repairs float stages.

Qualification Requirements

Five years of full-time paid experience, acquired within the past twelve years as a ship carpenter performing construction or repair work in a shipyard, on a tugboat or other ship or marine facility, at a dock, or waterfront facility or performing related marine carpentry.

Note:

This title is classified in the non-competitive class for a 12-month period under the New York Hiring Emergency Limited Placement Statewide Program – Local (NY HELPS Program). At the conclusion of 12 months incumbents will be transferred into "Ship Carpenter (92025)" as competitive class employees.

Probationary Period:

This title is subject to a 12-month probationary period. The period of probation may be served while in the non-competitive classification under the NY HELPS Program or in the competitive classification, or both. However, all employees must serve a total of 12 months of probation.
