

SUPERVISOR BRIDGE PAINTER (NY HELPS PROGRAM)

General Statement of Duties and Responsibilities

Under general supervision, supervises the work of painting bridge structures; performs related work.

Examples of Typical Tasks

Makes work assignments to Bridge Painters.

Supervises, directs and inspects the work of Bridge Painters who paint and repaint bridge structures.

Makes inspections of bridge structures for the preparation of work schedules.

Directs and supervises rigging and scaffolding operations.

Is responsible for the safety of assigned personnel.

May drive trucks and other motor vehicles to and from job sites.

Qualification Requirements

Six years of full-time satisfactory experience in painting bridges, towers, tanks, and other elevated structures where rigging and scaffolding are used, at least one year of which must have been in a supervisory capacity.

License Requirement

At the time of appointment, eligibles must possess a Class B Commercial Driver's License valid in the State of New York, with no restrictions. This License with no restrictions must be maintained for the duration of employment.

SUPERVISOR BRIDGE PAINTER (NY HELPS PROGRAM) (continued)

Note:

This title is classified in the non-competitive class for a 12-month period under the New York Hiring Emergency Limited Placement Statewide Program – Local (NY HELPS Program). At the conclusion of 12 months incumbents will be transferred into “Supervisor Bridge Painter (91871)” as competitive class employees.

Probationary Period:

This title is subject to a 12-month probationary period. The period of probation may be served while in the non-competitive classification under the NY HELPS Program or in the competitive classification, or both. However, all employees must serve a total of 12 months of probation.
